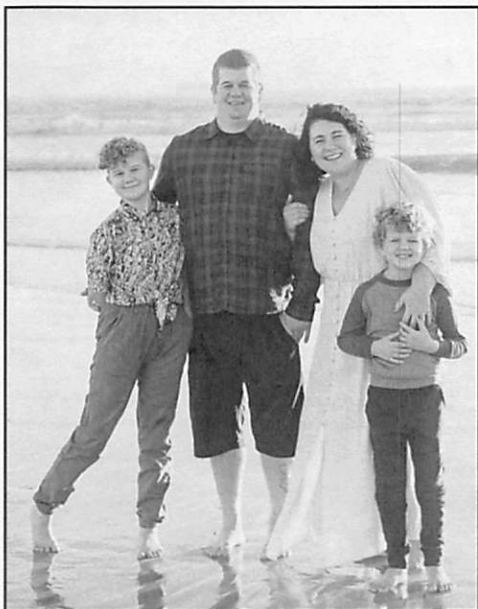
MEET SOME NEW NEIGHBORS!

PARMESAN PULL-A-PARTS

- 3 TBL Melted Butter
- ½ TSP Celery Seed
- ½ TSP Dill Weed
- ½ TSP Minced Dry Onion
- 1 Package Refrigerator Biscuits
- 2 TBL Grated Parmesan Cheese

Pour butter into 8-inch round cake pan. Add celery seed, dill weed and minced onion. Cut each biscuit in to fourths. Sprinkle parmesan cheese into cake pan then add rolls. Bake at 425° for 12-15 minutes.

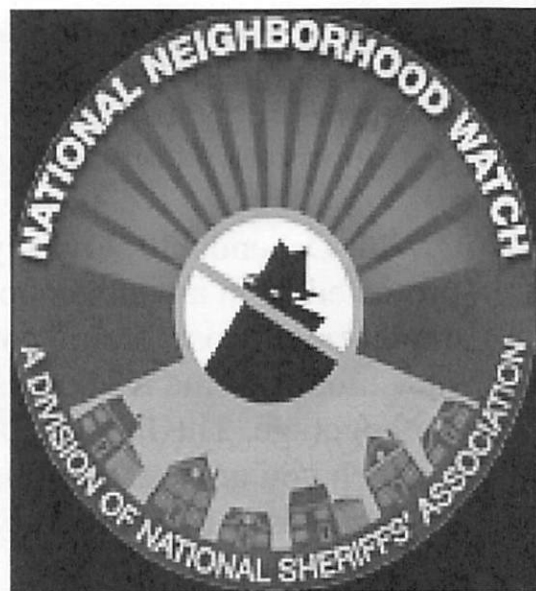
