ODOR CONTROL

If you smell an odor outside, it might be coming from the landfill at Miramar when they are turning over the mulch rows. They make mulch and compost for gardening, etc.

Please call the San Diego City environmental Services office to report the time and your location (specifically within the Park.)

if you ever experience any offensive odors, feel free to contact Mark zu Hone, the Miramar Landfill Operation's Manager, directly

at 858-518-3008 and he will quickly investigate if available.

MULCH – HOW IT'S MADE

Miramar Greenery mulch is made by a shortened composting process (15 days) using shredded tree and yard trimmings. During this two week period, micro-organisms digest the carbon and nitrogen rich mixture, causing the windrow to sustain temperatures of 140°-165° F. This process eliminates pathogens and most weed seeds while breaking down the raw organic material into beneficial soil nutrients. Mulch is considered a valuable product but must be appropriately applied to garner its benefits.

Create this little angel with just a paper plate,

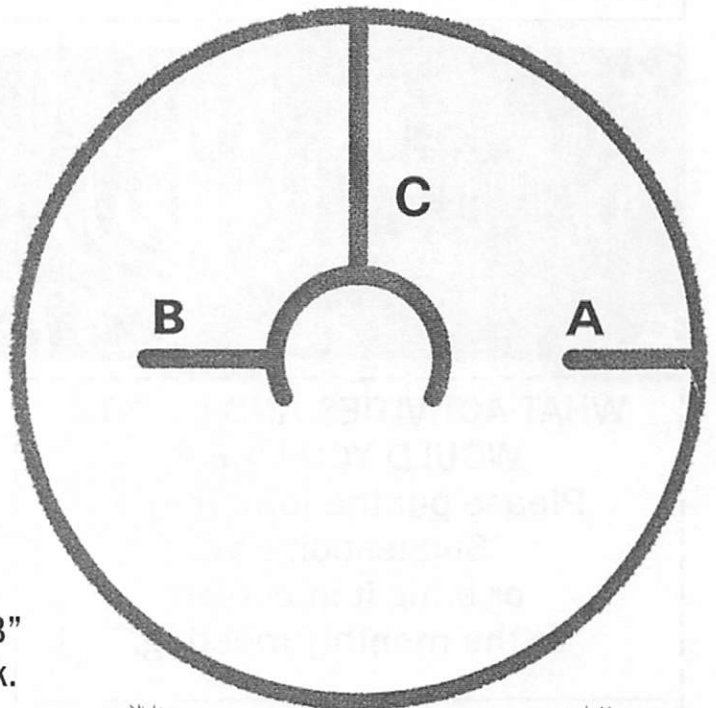
some drawing, and a few cuts.

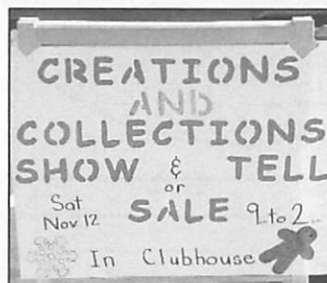
ANNUAL HOLIDAY DINNER
