BITS OF NEWS AND NOTES

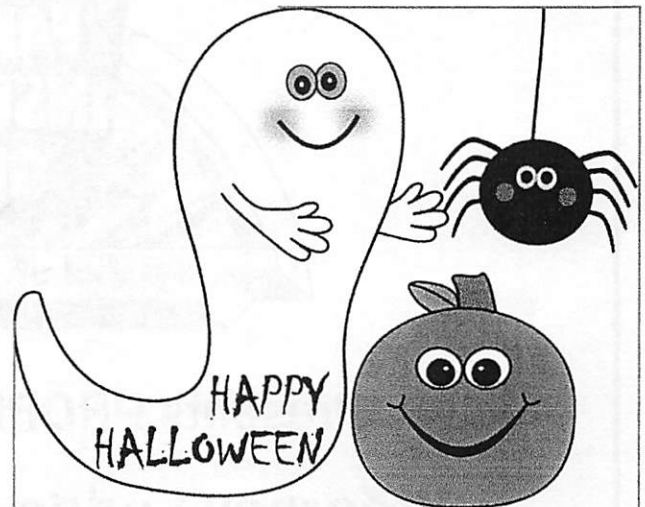
1. There will be NO MOVIE Nights for the rest of 2015 — Oct., Nov and Dec.

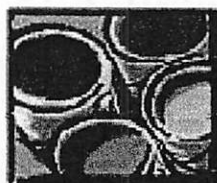

- 🐾 1 cup plain yogurt

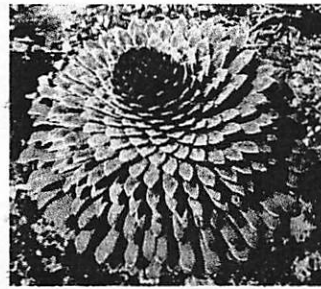
Blend all 3 until smooth.

Autumn is a good time to plant cuttings and starter plants and get the

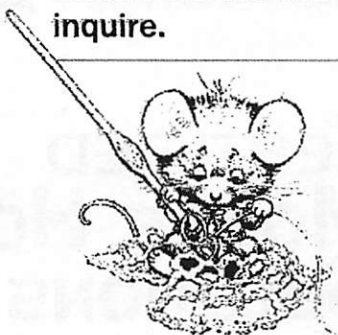

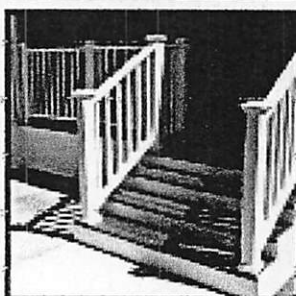
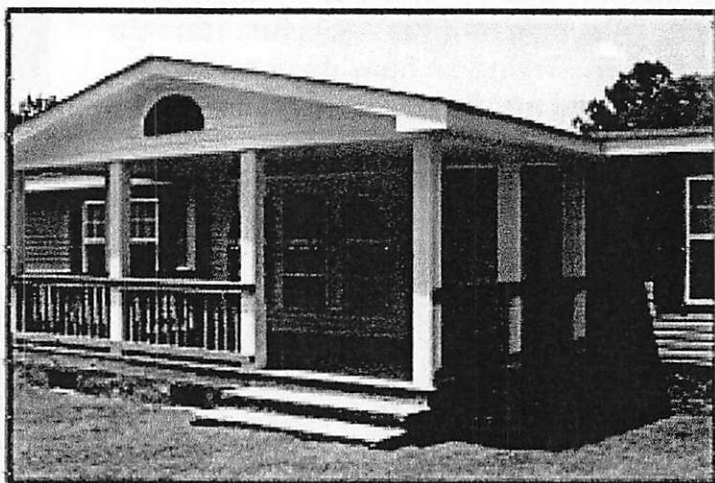

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- ✓ **Movable islands:** If there is a little extra floor space, making a kitchen island is not as difficult as one thinks. All that's needed is some old cabinetry, a desk, or even some reclaimed wood. Paint, stain, or varnish any wood to the style you desire. One can also buy a movable island.
- ✓ **Modular shelving:** Construct or add shelves on any available section of the wall or in closets is away of turning empty space into usable areas for whatever it is that needs to be close at hand in the kitchen; pots, plates, cookbooks, timers; really anything.
- ✓ **The Lazy Susan:** It's a great way to store just about anything. Try condiments on one in the fridge to free a lot of space and make it simpler to locate *that* jar. Try one in the pantry to organize spices.
- ✓ **Pegboards:** These are a versatile asset in the kitchen. They hold hooks for various utensils or baskets to store canned goods or spices. Paint them whatever color works and hang them on a wall.
- ✓ **Magnet knife storage:** Perhaps rooting through the kitchen drawers for the right knife for the right job is not a good idea. Magnetic strips installed over a kitchen work area are a convenient and safe way to store knives in the modern kitchen.
- ✓ **Tension rods:** Simple plastic or metal tension rods lend themselves as excellent space savers in the kitchen. For cleaning supplies, try installing one under the sink and hang cleaning products on them, while leaving the area underneath free for something else. Put them vertically in cabinets to act as dividers, or screw one into the wall as another place to hang kitchen utensils.

WORD HISTORY OF HALLOWEEN

In the Christian calendar, the first day of November is All Saints' Day, which honors all the saints in heaven. The usual earlier name for this day in English was *All Hallows Day* or *All Hallow Day*, and the previous evening (October 31) was called *All Hallows Eve* or *All Hallow Even*. (The word *hallow*, related to *holy*, meant "saint.") In Scotland *All Hallow Even* was contracted to *Hallow-e'en*, now spelled *Halloween*.

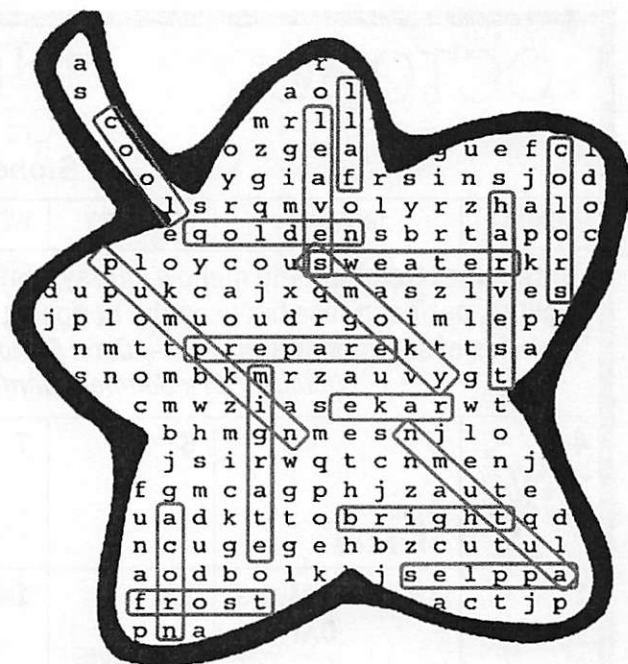

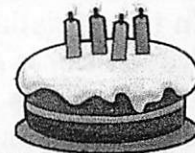
