Living the *life of Riley* means living the easy life, an existence marked by luxury and a carefree attitude. The term *living the life of Riley* is an American phrase; it first appeared in the early 1900s. There is some suggestion that the idea of a gentleman named Mr. Riley enjoying a luxurious, easy life is suggested in several earlier vaudeville songs, though the phrase *living the life of Riley* appears slightly later. In the beginning, Riley was also spelled as Reilly, the only spelling now recognized by the Oxford English Dictionary is *living the life of Riley*. The term *living the life of Riley* spread across American training camps during World War I; soldiers wrote home using the phrase, which popularized it. By the 1940s, the term *living the life of Riley* was well known enough to be used as the title of a popular radio comedy, "The Life of Riley", starring William Bendix.
