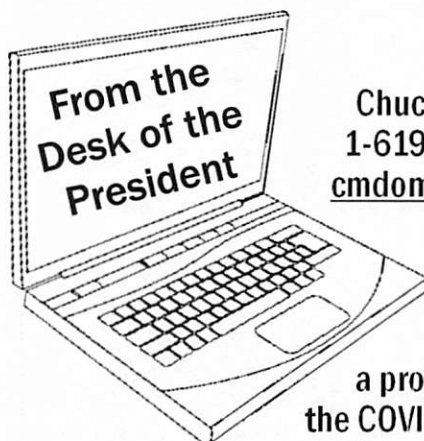

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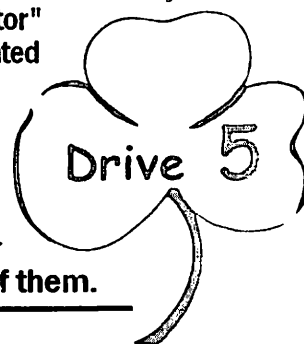

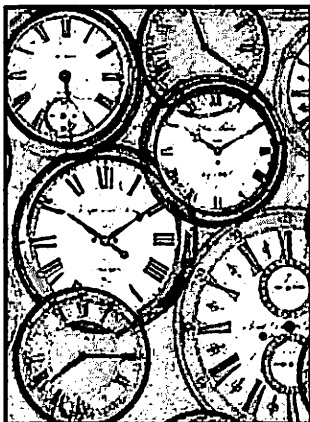

DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME (DST) is the practice of moving the clocks forward one hour from Standard Time during the summer months and changing them back again in the fall. The general idea is that this allows us all to make better use of natural daylight. However, DST has many detractors—and rightfully so. To remember which way to set their clocks, folks often use the expression, "Spring forward, fall back."

The correct term is "Daylight Saving Time" and not "Daylight Savings Time" (with an extra "s"), though many of us are guilty of saying it the wrong way. The technical explanation is that the word "saving" is singular because it acts as part of an adjective rather than a verb.

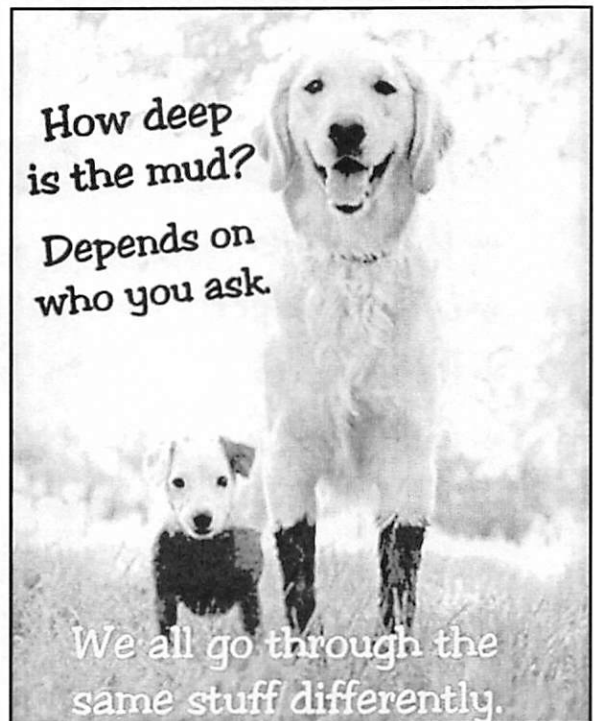
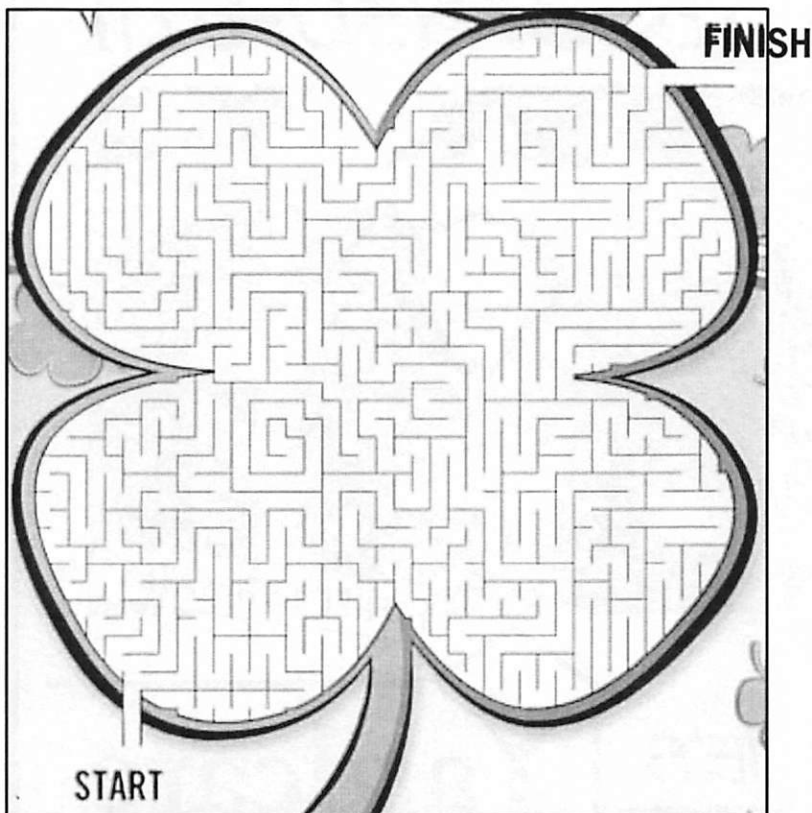

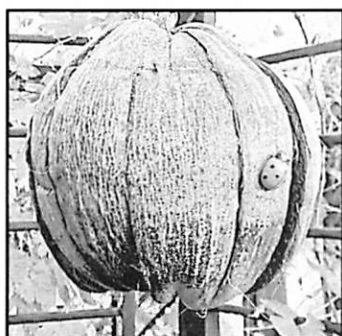

FACTS ABOUT LADYBIRDS/LADYBUGS



- Ladybirds are generally considered useful insects, and one of the greatest allies of the farmer and the gardener as many species feed on aphids or scale insects, which are pests in gardens, agricultural fields, orchards, and similar places.
- They are nature's own 'pest' controllers and are more effective than poisonous chemicals.
- Ladybirds lay hundreds of eggs in the colonies of aphids and other plant-eating pests. When they hatch, the lady-bird larvae immediately begin to feed. By the end of its three to six-week life, the larvae may eat some 5,000 aphids.
- The beneficial species of ladybirds kill aphids, chinch bugs, asparagus beetle larvae, alfalfa weevils, bean thrips, grape root worm, spider mites, Colorado potato beetle larvae, whiteflies, and mealybugs, among other insects.
- A single ladybird may consume as much as 40-50 per day of a wide variety of garden pests. In addition to being beneficial, their help comes cheap.
- Ladybirds are an inexpensive solution to warring on garden pests and are cheaper than chemical pesticides. They also won't hurt people, plants or pets. Finally, they are also a "self-renewing" form of insect control.

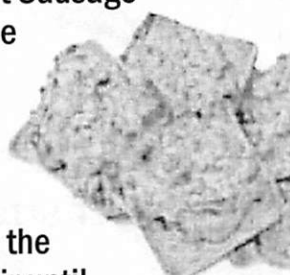

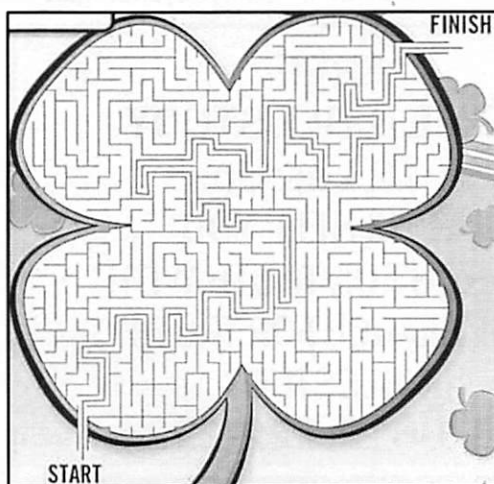
HOT MEAT HORS D'OEUVRE

- 1 lb. ground beef
- 1 lb. Jimmy Dean Hot Sausage
- 1 lb. Velveeta Cheese
- Rye Bread

Cut the rye bread into four pieces. Brown the meat. Cut cheese into small cubes. Add the cheese to meat and stir until completely melted. Spread on bread. Freeze. Reheat at 400° F. for 10 minutes. These are great for parties or to have with soup.

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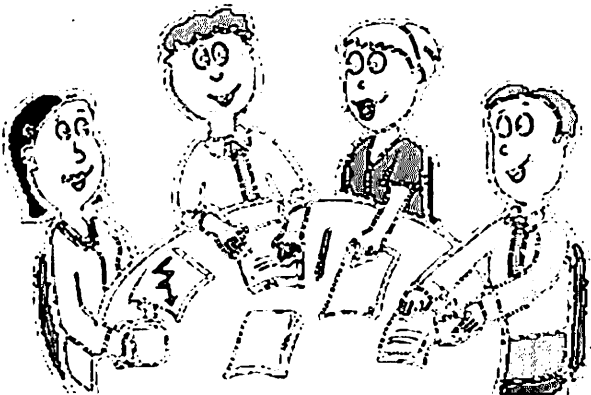
