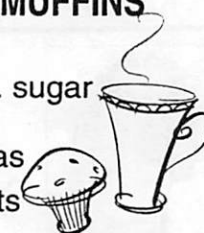
MICROWAVE BANANA MUFFINS

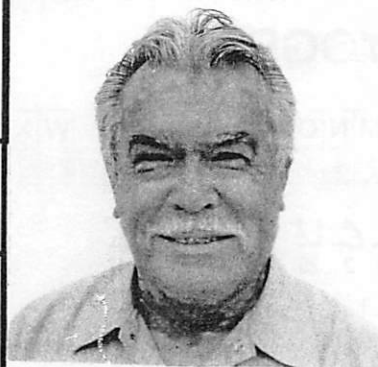

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TWELVE TIPS FOR SPENDING LESS

If you're trying to cut down on your spending, try following some of these strategies:

1. **Pay cash.** Keep yourself in touch with cost, by using cold hard cash.
2. **Focus on small items first.** When you buy an expensive item, it's easy to toss in many smaller items too – items that you might have otherwise have spent a lot of time considering, and which add up to a lot of \$\$\$\$. Buy the software, the mouse, the mouse pad, and other accessories, then choose the computer.
3. **Don't buy too much at one time.** If you're buying too many things, you stop paying attention to what you're getting.
4. **Don't buy anything at a bargain store that you haven't bought before at full price.**
5. **Make a list and stick to it.**
6. Before paying, **review each of your purchases** with a skeptical eye. Don't buy anything you are not sure you want and can or will use; this is particularly important with clothes.
7. **Don't tell yourself, "I can always return it";** remind yourself, "I can come back if I decide I need it."
8. **Don't buy anything that needs to be a specific size** unless you KNOW the measurements you need.
9. **Don't shop when you're hungry,** even for non-food items.
10. **Don't shop as an activity with friends.**
11. **Be very skeptical of anything that's on sale.**
12. **Stay out of stores.** If you don't shop, you don't buy.
