DID YOU KNOW?

Kearney Lodge was planned in 1963, the brainchild of several partnered families. It originally held 300 spaces comprised of 200 family spaces and 100 50+ spaces. We now have 325 homes and are an all-ages Park.

The word "Kearney" was likely of Gaelic Irish in origin, based on the family name and the probable place of origin is Tipperary, a town in the Republic of Ireland. The Kearney's were skilled artisans, who prospered in the 18th Century.


