DO YOU HAVE NOISY NEIGHBORS?

Our homes are very close together, much more so than in the average community. Please consider your neighbors; besides noise at any hour, many people have work shifts that require sleeping in the daytime.

TV, radios and other music players produce sounds that carry further than you may think. These should not be heard beyond 50 feet from the source.

Trash day is another time that people may

make a lot of noise, especially early in the morning. Please consider a hand truck or cans with wheels, or get someone to help you put your trash can on the street quietly.

Most carports and driveways in Kearney Lodge Park are right next to a neighbor's bedroom. If your vehicle is younger than 15 years, it doesn't need to run to warm up. Along the same line of thought, revving the engine is not necessary for the vehicle's performance. Besides the noise, there are the exhaust fumes, and it wastes your precious fuel. Car radios also should be turned down. Use the silent mode to turn your car alarms on and off; car alarms are not necessary in the park, just turn it off entirely and lock the car doors while you are at home.

You're not that noisy neighbor, are you?

SAN DIEGO SUMMER WATERING RULES CURRENTLY IN EFFECT

Summer rules that impact when and how often San Diego residents can water their lawns took effect again June 1, 2010.

Residents may water their lawns before 10 a.m. or after 6 p.m. three days a week from June through October, and for no more than 10 minutes at a time.

Compared to the rest of the year, summer Restrictions are different. The change for summer is to prevent people from watering during the heat of the day, when water quickly evaporates.

Throughout the year, apartments, condominiums and businesses can water only on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

MOBILEHOME PARKS are considered in the "apartment" category, so we can water on Mondays, Wednesday, and Fridays. (Yes, your editor checked on this.)



HOW TO STOP YOUR PUPPY FROM BITING

- •Begin your training early when your puppy is 6 weeks old, if possible.
- •Teach your puppy that biting hurts you. When she bites, give a sharp "no!" or "ouch!" or even a yelp like a dog would make. This is the reaction another puppy would have if she bit too hard during play. It teaches that she's been too rough, and she'll probably be gentler next time.
- •Remove your hand slowly. Don't jerk away, and give your puppy a toy that he can chew without damage.
- •If your puppy ignores your reaction and bites again, repeat your "no!," "ouch!" or yelp, and leave the room for a few minutes. Let your puppy know that when he bites, he will lose his playmate. This, too, mirrors the reaction he would get from another puppy if he played too roughly.
- •Be persistent in training. As your puppy's behavior improves and her bites are softer, continue to yelp or give a sharp "no!" or "ouch!" whenever she puts his teeth on you. Make it clear that all bites are painful and unacceptable to humans.
- •Reinforce your puppy's good behavior. Whenever he licks you without using his teeth and whenever he plays nicely and appropriately, give him plenty of praise.
- •Begin teaching the "off" command after your puppy has stopped biting with any pressure. Hold a handful of the puppy's dry food, close your hand and say "off." After a few seconds, if the puppy has not touched your hand, say "take it" and give her a piece of food. You are her that "off" means no touching.
- •Continue to give a sharp yelp, "no!" or "ouch!" any time your puppy bites you unexpectedly. If you see the bite coming, give the "off" command. Enroll your puppy in an obedience class where he can socialize with other dogs when he is about six months old. Their interaction will help to reinforce what you teach him, since rough play with other dogs will likely cause them to yelp and cut off play. At the same time, your puppy will learn the difference between people's limits and other dogs' limits dogs will allow rougher play than people will.
