

#### KEARNEY LODGE RESIDENTS ARE HELPING SAN DIEGO CITY and COUNTY


Dear KL residents, June will be my final month to take donations. I'm going back to work.



#### SUPER PANCAKES

These are delicious and easy to make. They brown beautifully and don't stick to the pan.

#### **INGREDIENTS**

1/3 Cup Yogurt or Kefir 1 Egg

<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> Cup Milk 2 Tbsp. Oil 1 Cup Flour

1 Tbsp Sugar (Optional)

1 Tsp. Baking Powder

½ Tsp. Baking Soda ½ Tsp. Salt Mix egg, yogurt, milk, and oil. Stir in flour, sugar, baking powder, baking soda, and salt. DO NOT mix until smooth. There should be bumps. Flip pancakes when air bubbles start popping. Makes 10-12 medium-sized pancakes.

#### SLOW COOKER BLACKBERRY COBBLER

EQUIPMENT: 5 qrt or larger oval Slow Cooker

#### INGREDIENTS BLACKBERRY LAYER:

- · 3-5 cups blackberries rinsed and drained
- · 1 Tbsp. cornstarch
- 2 Tbsp. salted butter melted ¼ cup sugar COBBLER LAYER:
- 1 ½ cups Bisquick baking mix
- 1 cup milk`
- ¼ cup melted butter
- 1 Tbsp. sugar TOPPING
- 1 Tbsp. sugar
- ¼ tsp. cinnamon

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Add the rinsed blackberries to the slow cooker. Sprinkle with the ¼ cup sugar, 1 tablespoon cornstarch and 2 Tablespoons melted butter. Stir these items together. If you want a pureed sauce, use a potato masher and mash the berries at this step. In a medium-sized bowl, combine cobbler layer ingredients. Stir until combined; some lumps are fine. DO NOT over mix. Evenly pour this batter over the blackberries. Spread out with a spatula.
- In a small bowl combine the tablespoon of sugar and ¼ tsp. cinnamon. Sprinkle this over the batter.
- 3. Place the lid on the slow cooker. Cook on HIGH for 2 hours and 15 minutes. Do not lift the lid during the cooking time.

OPTIONAL: Use one or a mixture of these fruits:

- Raspberries
- Marionberries
- Sliced peaches
- Boysenberries
- Blueberries
  - Serve with ice cream or whipped cream.

#### NATURAL APHID SPRAY

There are many varieties of aphids and they feed on a wide range of plants, giving them yellowing, distorted leaves, affecting growth and in severe cases, even killing the plant. Ladybugs are their natural predator but since most gardeners don't have ladybugs on hand, a natural aphid killer is the next best thing, and the most convenient too.

#### INGREDIENTS:


- 3 tbsp organic dish soap (soap will dissolve the waxy coat on aphids, dehydrating them without harming the plant)
- 8 oz. tap water
- · spray bottle

#### DIRECTIONS:

- Mix ingredients in the spray bottle and give it a good shake.
- Generously spray the plants on the affected areas and including the underside of leaves.
   Leave on overnight. Hose down the plants the next day, making sure the water flow won't damage the plants. Let the plants air dry.
- Lightly mist the solution again after drying. You should see your plants getting back to a healthy green color within a few days, up to a week (that is if they weren't already killed by aphids before the treatment was applied).


NOTE: you may need to repeat the process if you are fighting a big infestation! Just check your plants regularly and repeat at the first sign of infestation.


