

YARDS OF THE MONTH

At the July KLCC meeting the Chair of the Yard of the Month committee was transferred from Ron (our VP who has done this job for years almost single-handed) to Wendy (Block Captain for section 12 in the Park). Members at this meeting voted to approve the following considerations for choosing monthly yards.

First, the community decided that the age of the home, the length of the owner's residency, the size of the yard, and whether the home is a single- or double-wide doesn't matter. Second, the community agreed on the following list of qualifying factors:

- Space number must be visible
- Weeds and dead leaves should be minimal
- · House paint should not be peeling
- · Yard, porch, walkway, and driveway should be clutter-free
- Landscaping should be aesthetic to community members present at KLCC meeting where voting takes
 place, and can be traditional, creative, and/or unique as long as it meets the Park's requirements for
 outdoor appearance (the Park Office has a list of these requirements)
- · Second nominations for any space should not occur until all other qualified homes have been chosen

Any community member can nominate a yard for consideration by placing nominations in the Suggestion Box located near the back entrance to the Park Office, or telling any KLCC Board Member what space to add to the nominations. The Chair of the committee will make sure these nominations meet the qualifying factors above and take pictures of them prior to the next monthly meeting so members can vote for the next "winner." Those homes that do not win that month will be re-submitted for consideration at the next month's meeting along with any new nominations. The Chair of the committee will remove the Yard of the Month sign from last month's yard and take it to the new Yard of the Month along with a \$20 cash prize (!), and seek permission from the owner to submit a picture of the yard to the newsletter. A yard can win even if the owner does not want a picture of his/her yard to appear in the newsletter. A map of prior winning yards will be posted in the Clubhouse (once it is completed).
