L. on a monthly basis. There's a place and purpose for everyone here at the KLCC Community Connection!

As of February 1, 2017, KLCC will fold if 2 volunteers do not step up to serve our community on the board. This means "The Connector" publication will disappear, individualized enhancements to the park will cease to flourish, (such as the development of the dog run on the east side of the park, laundry room upgrades, the Cactus Garden, installation of K. L. street signs), personal influence on management, (such as voicing parking concerns, effecting change in neighbor/pet annoyances, etc.)






