WINTER PREP

CHECK FOR AIR LEAKS AROUND WINDOWS

Make sure your home is shut tight by running a simple candle test. Look at all places in your home where two different materials meet as well as external facing doors and windows. Hold a lit candle and slowly move it around the window frame to see if the flame follows a draft. A simple helping of caulk around these leaks could save you 5-15% on your heating and cooling costs.

You can even use weather sealing tape around windows instead of caulk, but the finished product will rely heavily on your ability to tape cleanly.

WHY YOU SHOULD NEVER TRIM YOUR DOG'S OR CAT'S WHISKERS

Analysis by Dr. Karen Shaw Becker, DVM — October 10, 2020

- Unlike human facial hair, the whiskers sprouting from your dog's or cat's face serve a very important function and should never be trimmed or cut.
- Dog and cat whiskers, aka vibrissae, are sensory organs that transmit important information to your pet's brain; whisker trims are the equivalent of temporary amputations.
- Cats may experience bowl or dish aversion from food or water bowls that are too small or deep, causing the whiskers to rub against the sides of the bowl during eating or drinking. SEE SOURCE BELOW.

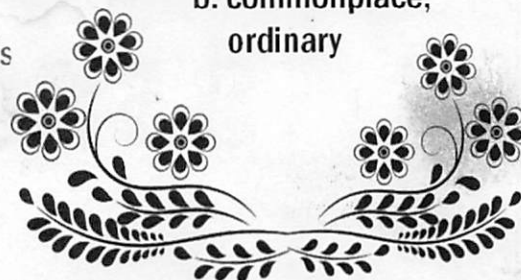

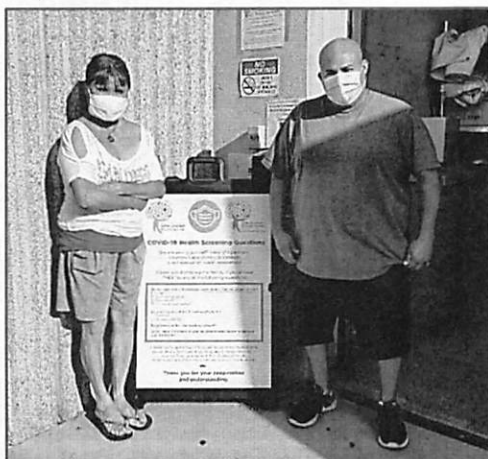

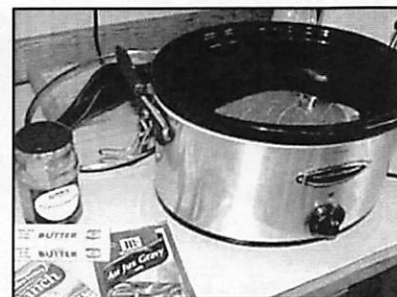

CROCK-POT CHUCK ROAST

1. Buy a chuck
roast.
2. Put in the
crock pot.
3. Sprinkle
Ranch dress-
ing on top.
4. Sprinkle Au Jus mix on top.
5. Put a stick of butter on top
6. Put about 5 pepperoncini peppers
on top (Buy them in a jar.)
7. Do NOT add water
8. Cook in crock-pot on low
for about eight (8) hours.



NOTE: Optional additions:

One or more of the following:

1 pkg Lipton onion soup mix, 1 cup water,
1 can of cream of mushroom soup, Italian
seasoning, black pepper, sautéed mushrooms,
onions, green pepper, carrots, celery, and/or
potatoes.

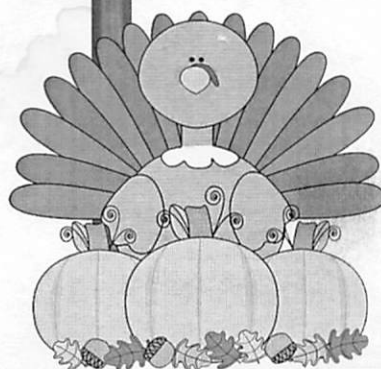
