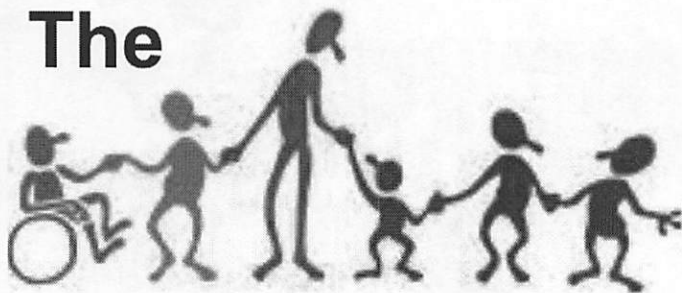

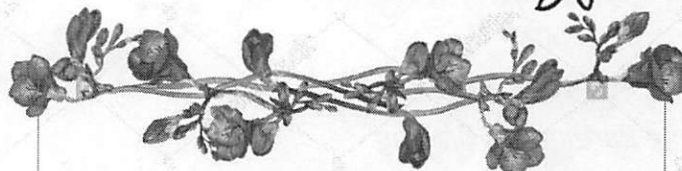

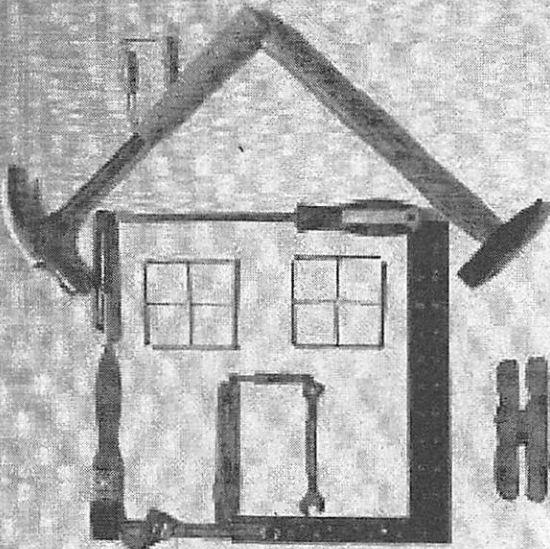
In Memory of Alice Pilcher Tiernan

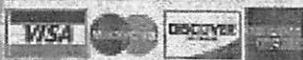
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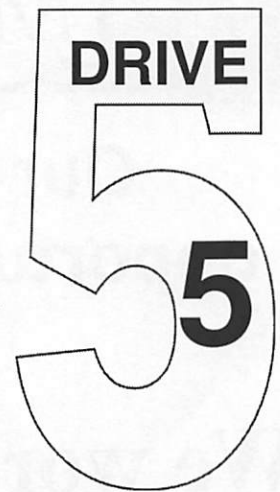

- The KL resident photo album is in the works. All KL-related photos are welcome for consideration. Contact Secretary Amber Bennett about any contributions.

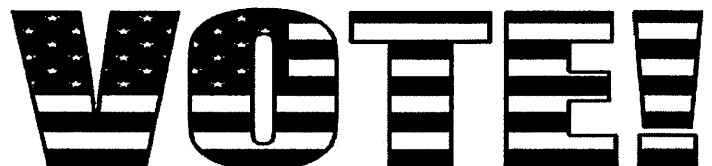
NEW BUSINESS:

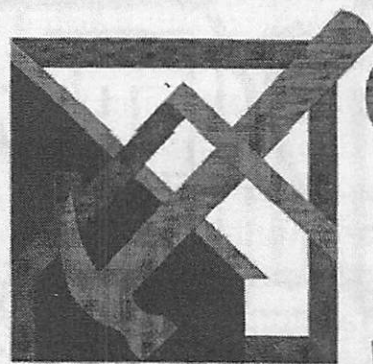
1. The KLCC elects volunteers for the following offices: President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary.

Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.

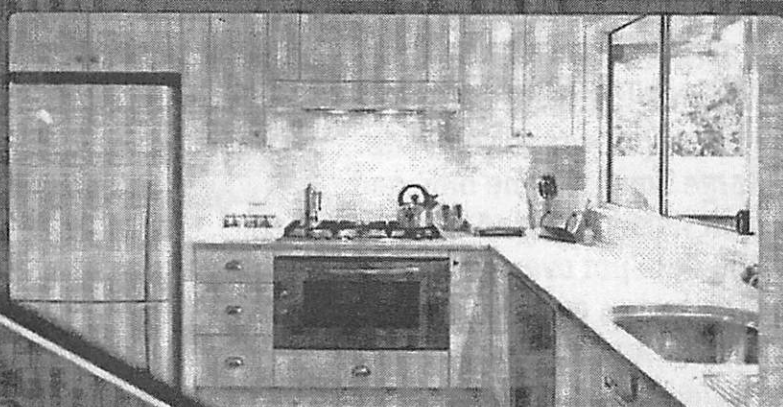
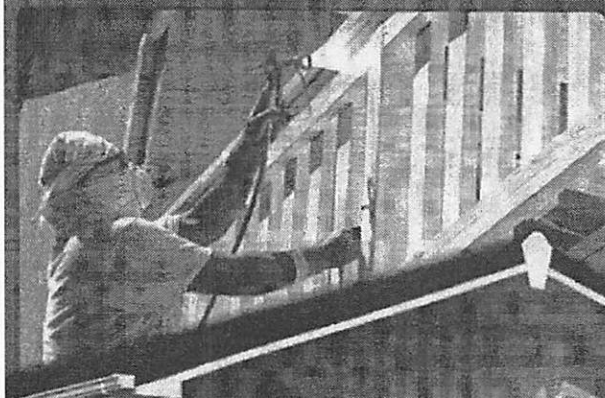
