FALL FLOWERS FOR YOUR GARDEN

Add some beautiful color to your flower gardens this fall. These fall flowers to plant in your garden can withstand those chilly nights and bring vibrant colors to any fall day! Just because it is fall is doesn't mean you have to hang up those gardening gloves yet. Add some hardy fall flowers to your garden. Below are suggestions for six fall flowers to plant.

1. Mums (Chrysanthemums)

They come in variety of warm colors and usually bloom for about three weeks depending on the climate.

2. Winter Pansies Get a jump on your spring planting. Plant and enjoy their flowers now and again in the spring.

3. Fall Rudbeckia There are both perennial and annual varieties of Rudbeckia. This is the annual variety and will not come back in the spring.

 Asters These add superb color in the fall. Plants are very hardy and come in a wide range of bright colors.

Montauk Daisies These perennials bloom late summer to early fall and will come back year after year. They produce large white flowers.

6. Flowering Cabbage Just as the name suggests, these plants look like a colorful cabbage. There is really no "flower" to the flowering cabbage, these colorful plants are frost-resistant and very long-lasting. They are the longest lasting of the fall flowers, usually until Thanksgiving and sometimes even longer depending on the climate zone.
