H. JAMES (JIM) GRAY

January 25, 1928 to September 24, 2017

Jim was born in Elytia, Ohio to Ruth and Leo Gray; the oldest of

10 children. Jim was a farmer in his younger days, before enlisting in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War. Jim and a former wife had three sons, Mark, Guy, and Gary (deceased). He also adopted a fourth son, Glenn.

On December 24, 1986, he married Ora. Soon after their marriage, They moved into the Kearney Lodge Mobile Home Park, in unit 310. Jim became very important in the lives of Ora's three children who loved him dearly.

The Navy sent Jim to the front lines of the Korean conflict. His plane crashed over Korea on October 16, 1951. Because of the crash, he received the "Purple Heart" and medical discharge for an abdominal wound. He also received the following medals; Japanese Occupation; American Defense; China Service; Good Conduct; Korean Campaign; Air Medal; Combat Air crewman wings; and United Nations.

Jim was a Loyal Order of Moose life member of the Kearney Mesa Moose Lodge. He joined the lodge on May 22, 1980 and became very active. He went thru all the chairs at least twice, and he was voted in as the Lodge Governor three times. He was a top ritualist on many occasions. Jim received Moose Legionnaire degree on February 9, 1981; Fellowship Degree on May 26, 1987, and he received the highest degree of the Order, the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in the House of God, in Illinois, on May 28, 2005.

Jim was known as the flag man because he displayed all of the military and American flags on every holiday. He loved John Wayne and the American eagle. He was a good friend, father and husband. He will be missed by all.

We extend our sincere sympathy to the family, friends, neighbors, and colleagues of H. James (Jim) Gray.







ABOUT OPOSSUMS

Opossums are among the most primitive mammals. Fossil ancestry goes back 70 Million years. They have survived by adapting to human habitat, and being able to eat just about anything. They are beneficial in that they help to keep the balance of nature.

Opossums are often mistaken for rats. They are not rodents, they are marsupials. They are not aggressive toward humans or pets but they will attempt to defend themselves if cornered.

Opossums are relatively disease free. They do not carry Parvo virus, distemper or rabies. They are actually an excellent animal to have around your property because they eat rats, mice, snails, slugs and insects. They also eat over-ripe fruit that has fallen to the ground. They are called "omnivores" because they meat as well as vegetables and fruit.

Opossums are nest builders. They are also nocturnal. They spend much of the day in their dens. At night, they forage for food. They are excellent climbers using all their hands, feet and tail to grasp.

CO-EXISTING WITH OPOSSUMS:

- ✓ Secure trash can lids so that opossums cannot get into them; secure trash cans in a shed or garage.
- ✓ Eliminate access to food in your yard; place pet food inside, secure pet doors at night, pick up fallen fruit around the garden, restrict the use of birdseed.
- ✓ Block holes in fences with wire or wood.
- ✓ Trim branches that provide access to your house.
- ✓ Bright lights, loud sounds, and ammonia-soaked rags may act as deterrents.

If you suspect that an opossum is in your attic, under your porch, etc., sprinkle baking flour around the area. This will allow you to identify the entrance to the area that the opossum is using. Once you have identified the entrance to the den, sprinkle flour around it again. You must wake up early in the morning before the opossum can return. If there are footprints indicating that it has left, seal the entrance temporarily using wire mesh. If there are no further signs of an opossum in the area, permanently seal the hole.

Many years ago, your *editor* was told by wildlife rescue personnel that possums cannot not climb slick surfaces nor jump up very far; however they can climb wherever there are crevices to grab. If a possum gets into a nearly empty trash can, it cannot get out. Solution: tip the trash can away from you so it can run and hide.






