


READ ALL ABOUT IT!





FAMILY-FAVORITE MACARONI AND CHEESE (lighter recipe) Prep 25 min - Total 50 min - Serves 6

INGREDIENTS

2 cups uncooked elbow macaroni (7 ounces)


2 tbsps margarine 1/4 cup all-purpose flour

1/2 tsp salt 1/4 tsp pepper 1/4 tsp ground mustard

1/4 tsp Worcestershire sauce 2 cups (skim) milk

1 1/2 cups reduced-fat shredded or cubed sharp Cheddar cheese (6 oz.)

Heat oven to 350°F. Cook macaroni as directed on package. While macaroni is cooking, melt margarine in a3-quart saucepan over low heat. Stir in flour, salt, pepper, mustard and Worcestershire sauce. Cook over medium low heat, stirring constantly, until mixture is smooth and bubbly: remove from heat. Stir in milk. Heat to boiling, stirring constantly. Boil and stir 1 minute. Stir in cheese. Cook, stirring occasionally, until cheese is melted. Drain macaroni. Gently stir macaroni Into cheese sauce. Pour into ungreased 2-quart casserole. Bake uncovered 20 to 25 minutes or until bubbly. DIY JEWELRY TRAY USING OLD SCARVES SUPPLIES:

- Old scarves. Thin, filmy scarves work best.
- Wooden tray. Find simple wooden trays from the craft store at reasonable prices. Some toys come with wooden trays.
- Mod Podge
 Brush

Step 1: Coat the bottom and interior sides of the tray in Mod Podge.


Step 2: Lay the scarf into the tray. Starting from the center, press down and out to the sides to get it smooth.

Step 3: Let the inside dry before wrapping the scarf around the edges. Once the middle is dry, you won't be pulling the scarf and having to reposition it often to keep it smooth.

Step 4: Paint the outside and the bottom of the tray with Mod Podge. Then wrap the scarf over the edge. You can Mod Podge the entire length of the scarf on the bottom or just do a section at a time, and then cut away any excess scarf length after it dries. If your scarf is thicker, you can cut and fold the edges, and then Mod Podge the heck out of them.
