- 2. Raffle money was collected from those who wanted to participate.
- 3. Joe moved to approve the minutes from 1/12/12. Motion unanimously approved.

COMMITTEE REPORT:

- 1. Emergency Preparedness—Chair, Cheryl Clark.
- a. Cheryl distributed a list of questions for block captains to ask of residents. Several suggestions were made throughout the discussion to include additional questions: add email address; ask if homeowner would like their phone/email included on a public park directory. Discussion of creating a park directory will wait until block captains know whether there are enough people who want to be placed on a public directory.
- b. Once a block captain has completed the questions for his or her block, Cheryl will compile the information that will be retained only for use in an emergency. Only board officers and this committee's chair will have a copy of the final version.
- c. The following members volunteered to be block captains. Cheryl will use a park map to identify approximately 30 homes for each captain. Because many of the volunteers live on or near the same street(s), it is likely that a captain's block may not be close to his or her own home.

TWO WAYS TO ATTRACT HUMMINGBIRDS

These ideas may increase your enjoyment of their habits and antics.

- Take a hardhat and mount a sugar-water feeder to the front to get an up close and personal view. You should use safety glasses when you are wearing the feeder hat. It has only one feeding port, but you may have many hummingbirds buzzing around your head at the same time!
- Try a single folding clothesline to hang your sugar-water feeders. The clothesline is the perfect size for the birds to perch. The whole unit revolves, making it easy to refill the feeders, and it folds up for storage. It's a great way to feed several hummingbirds at once.


