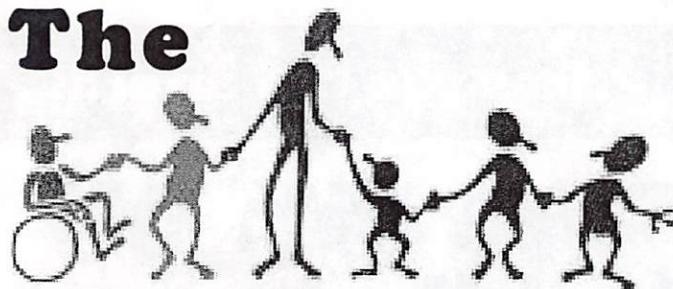

August 29, 1938 - June 28, 2013

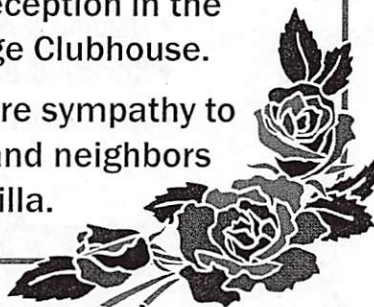
Cha Cha was born in San Diego, Texas. She graduated from Kearny High School, then had a career in Viking Plastics and Tupper Ware.

We extend our sincere sympathy to the family, friends and neighbors of Cha Cha Escamilla.

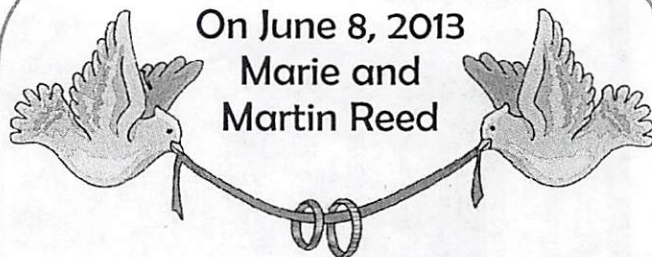


CPR CLASS

MEETING of 11 JULY 2013

Meeting called to order at 7:03 PM.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

HOUSEKEEPING CONCERNS:

1. Minutes approved as published in the newsletter; Nadine confirmed that the treasurer's report from June was accurate
2. Joe reminded everyone to follow rules of order, to submit voluntary dues, and to enter the raffle if desired

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Street names: most have been posted on at least one end of each street; eventually, signs will be posted at each end of each street. Reminder that these are for internal use only and are NOT considered part of your postal address.
2. Newsletter ads: no new ones this month
3. Transportation: Ellen has been busy and is now being compensated
4. Shuffleboard party to be held on July 21 at 6 PM. Ellen will have all equipment out and ready. No alcohol; bring your own refreshments.
5. Rummage sale: to be held September 21. Sign up in the office. Bill and Alex will post signs and advertisements.
6. Movie night: to be held July 17, 7 PM. Joe will post sign in the park; Alex will post on Kearney Lodge website/Facebook. Next two movie nights proposed for AUG 7 and AUG 21, if the clubhouse is available.
 - a. Point of interest: names for the two community "rooms" are (1) Clubhouse, which is located at the front of the park, and (2) Pool Room, which is located at the pool in the back of the park.
7. Bulletin board: Joe was applauded for creating an attractive new bulletin board. He has the key and will replace the display at the beginning of each month.

7. a. Joe received a complaint about the colorful "equal" sign on the board with the suggestion that it has political overtones. Sentiments expressed at the meeting were that anonymous complaints seem unfair and that it would be more helpful if people would get involved by coming to the meetings rather than just complaining from the sidelines. However, Joe agreed not to place the "equal" sign on the board in the future.
- b. Summer barbecue (not luau): managers have not yet determined whether this will be held this year—stay tuned.
- c. House numbers: park managers are following up. A suggestion was made that anyone with a talent for making numbers offer to help residents who don't have numbers create them—could post in the newsletter.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Suggestion box items
 - a. See the complaint noted above regarding the new bulletin board.
 - b. David D. presented an excellent summary of the problems Kearney Lodge faces with regard to speeding in the park. Joe will post the full suggestion on the bulletin board for August. David's suggestion was to start a campaign to have residents sign a pledge and put stickers on their cars as a way to change the culture in the park around safe driving. This will be placed on the agenda for fuller discussion next month. Please come to listen and express your thoughts—such a campaign will require volunteers and enough interest to generate a change.
2. Issues from the floor
 - a. Complaint about damaged clothes due to improper use of community washers and dryers. The cleaning service comes MWF so it may help to do your laundry on the days after the service has been here. This also evoked a discussion about how to be heard—there are complaint forms on the table inside the Clubhouse. Pick up a couple and keep them on hand to fill out and turn in to the park office.
 - b. There was a vote to remove the 10-minutes "Venting" or discussion period from the agenda.

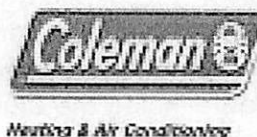

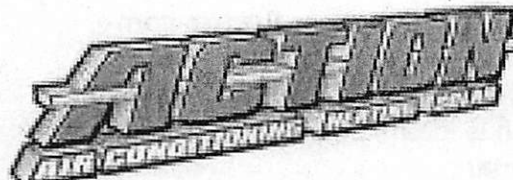

KEARNEY LODGE SUGGESTION

from our neighbor, David.

FACT: Kearney Lodge (KL) tenants, visitors and delivery trucks fail to obey the posted speed limit, thus increasing the risk of accidents involving pedestrians, kids-at-play, and other vehicles.

PROPOSAL: KL Tenant culture change through community involvement.

- Initiate a volunteer community campaign to change driving habits of those transiting KL. Have an initial 3-day "Pledge Drive" (Fri-Sun) during high traffic periods. Event would consist of having transiting drivers sign a pledge to drive safely and within the posted speed limits. They would receive a small sticker stating "I Pledge to Drive 5 MPH in Kearney Lodge" to post on the lower-left inside of their windshield as a constant reminder. Repeat Pledge drive every 3 months.
- Request KLM replace current 5-mph speed limit signs with signs that communicate "I Pledge to Drive 5 MPH".
- Request KLM assistance in repeat communication of the "I Pledge to Drive 5 MPH" slogan in all official correspondence (billing, newsletters, etc.) Request KLM obtain a pledge signature during signing and resigning of tenant leases.
- Periodically place orange cones randomly throughout the park with a small sign on top stating "I Pledge to Drive 5 MPH".

PROGRAM TO HELP PAY FOR MEDICINES

"Extra Help" from Medicare – called "low-income subsidy" or LIS. There are certain limits on yearly income and resources for qualification. See Section 3 of the *Medicare & You 2013* handbook or call 1-800-633-4227. TTY users may call 1-877-486-2048. All calls can be made 24 hours/7 days a week for free.

You may also call the Social Security Office at 1-800-772-1213 between 7am–7pm M – F. TTY users may call 1-800-325-0778 or call the California Medicaid Office.
