I thought that maybe if I acted "Crazy" then he would tell me to take a few days off. So I hung upside-down on the ceiling and made funny noises.

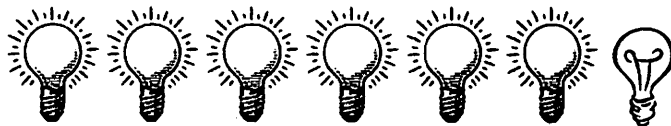
My co-worker asked me what I was doing.

2. Transportation—Sylvia has resigned from this task; Ellen and Linda are still available.
3. Shuffleboard — Every Sunday from 5 to 7 PM. Come meet your neighbors and have some fun with the refurbished game boards.
4. Fall rummage sale: sign up in the office; a KLCC table will be available for donated items to sell.
5. Movie night—16 people attended the first event; only 3 attended the 2nd night. Next dates are SEP 10 and 24, from 6 to 8 or 9 PM. Check the bulletin board for details. If you want to lend a DVD,, call Joe (see page 3).
6. Bulletin board—members present praised Joe for his creativity; come check it out—good information presented clearly. Check for periodic updates.
7. Barbecue—tabled for next year.

10. Potluck meetings — members present agreed to discontinue for now; anyone who wants to have a potluck in the future can suggest it from the floor.

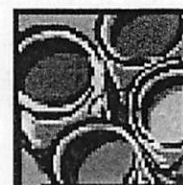
NEW BUSINESS:

2. Wendy suggested that the By-Laws be changed to hold Board Member elections in January in the future since it appears to be difficult for some of us to remember this in August! Voting on this change will take place at the October meeting since 60 days notice is required.

PROGRAMS TO HELP PAY FOR MEDS

"Extra Help" from Medicare. You may be able to get Extra Help for your prescription drug costs. This program is also called the "low-income subsidy" or LIS. People with qualifying annual income and resources may apply. See Section 3 the *Medicare & You* 2013 handbook or call 1-880-633-4227 toll-free, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. You may also call the Social Security Office at 1-800-772-1213 M-TH 7 am to 7 pm.

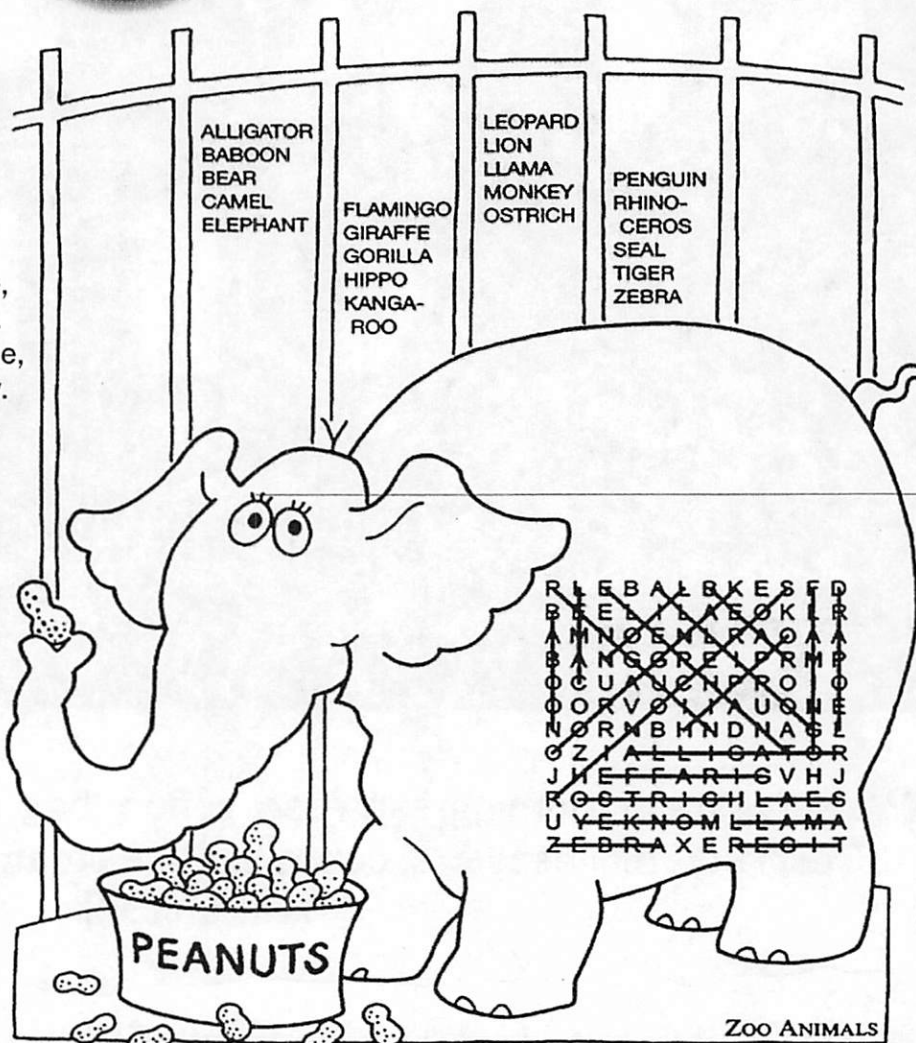
Other resources are the state Medicaid Office, a State Pharmaceutical Assistance Program (SPAP), and a State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP). The name and phone numbers are in Chapter 2, Section 3 of the *Evidence of Coverage* handbook.

SAFETY: GUNS

One-third of all the families in America that have children also have firearms, and more than 40 % of them don't keep their firearms locked up. Children younger than eight can't tell the difference between a real gun and a toy, and are strong enough to pull the trigger on a real gun. Is it any wonder that more than half of all unintentional shootings are committed by a child or a teenager?

- Teach children that they shouldn't touch guns, and that if they see one, to leave it alone and notify an adult.
- If your children play at another home, talk to the parents about gun safety.
- Treat every gun as if it were loaded.
- While target shooting, know your target and what is beyond it.
- Always point a firearm down and in a safe direction, never at people.
- Always store guns unloaded.
- Keep ammunition in a separate place, and lock it up.
- Lock firearms in a rack or safe, and hide the keys or combination.
- If there is mental illness in your home, severe depression, or potential for violence, don't just lock up guns - get rid of them.

More than three million BB guns and pellet guns are sold in the U.S. every year, as well. These tips apply to them, too.

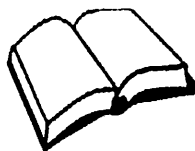
