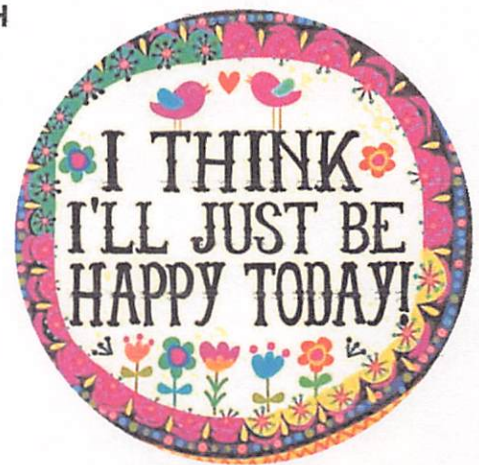
PARK DRIVING RULES

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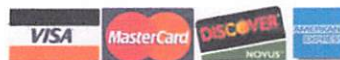
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TRANSPORTATION SERVICE

leaving many fond memories.

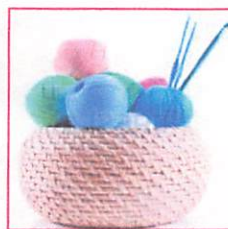
Bob was predeceased by his wife, Arlene,

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EXTEND SMART PHONE BATTERY LIFE



- **DELETE UNUSED APPS** – of approximately 40 apps on your device, you probably use about 10; you can delete the rest except built-in apps.
- **DON'T LET ALL APPS RUN ALL THE TIME** – turn off the ones you're not using – especially check those that are using power in the back-ground.
- **TURN OFF NOTIFICATIONS** that do not interest you.
- **TURN OFF LOCATION SERVICES** on social media.
- **TURN OFF BLUETOOTH** if you don't use it.
- **CHARGE MOST 2016 SMART PHONES** – most 2016 models don't require draining before re-charging. Put your device on charge for 15 minutes before running out the door.
- **DIM THE BRIGHTNESS OF THE DISPLAY** – your eyes will quickly adjust.
- **DON'T USE VIBRATE** – ringing uses just a little less battery power
- **DECREASE DISPLAY TIME** – Use a timer to turn off the display in 30- 60 seconds.

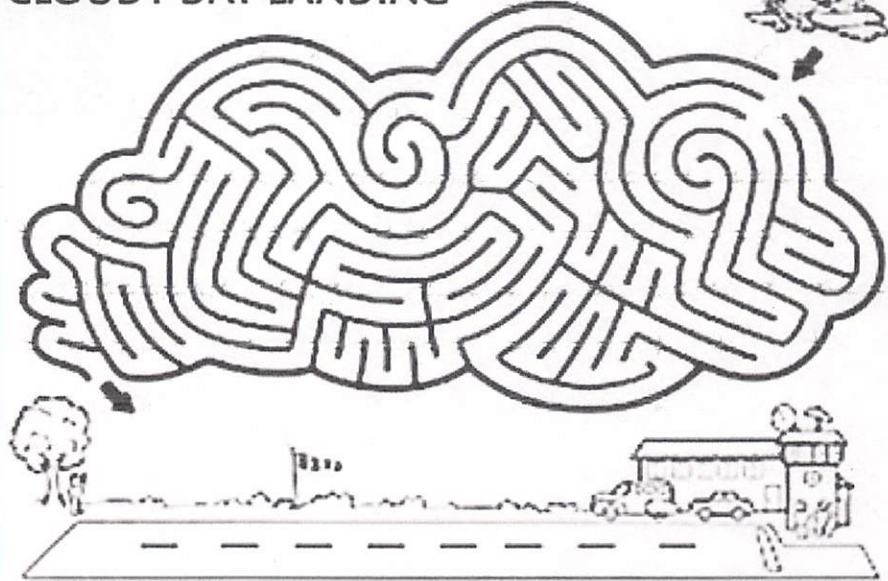

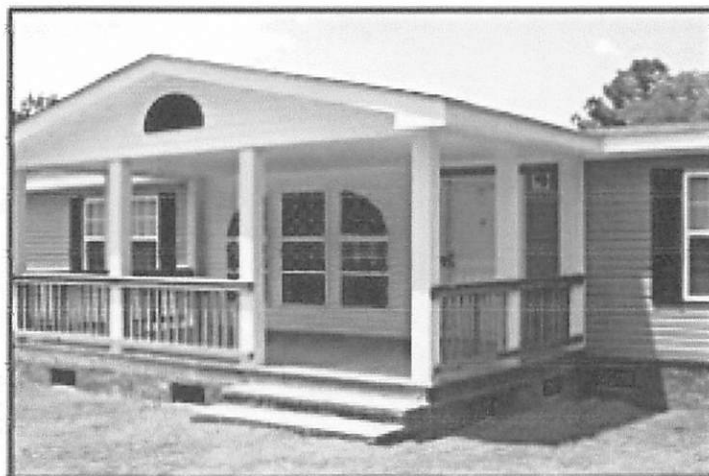

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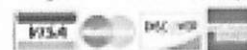
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PLANNING FOR THE RUMMAGE SALE

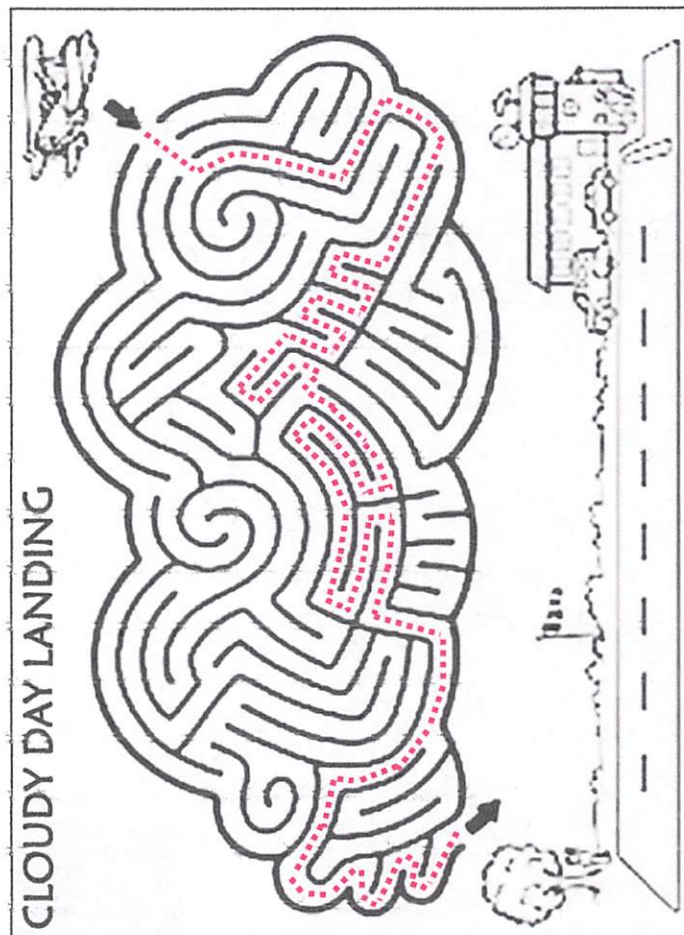
