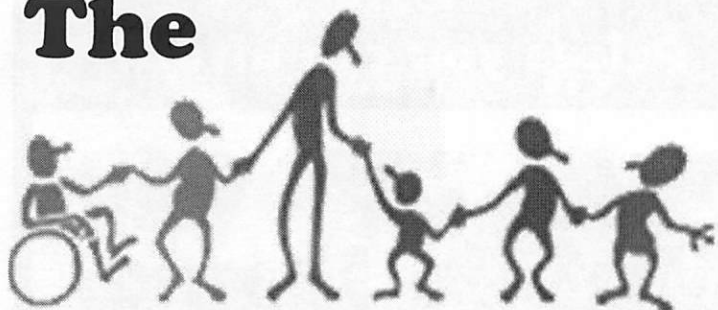
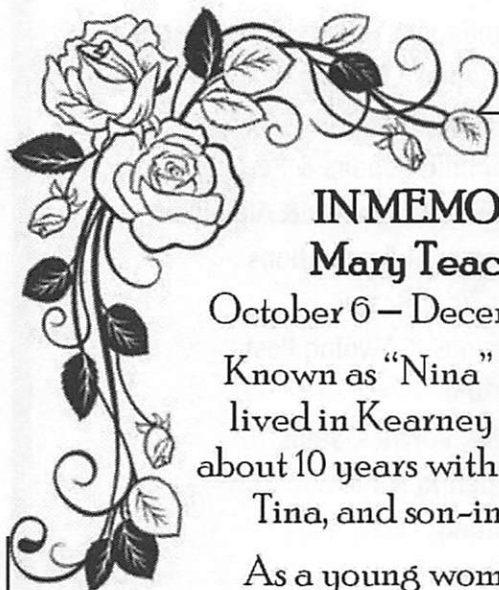

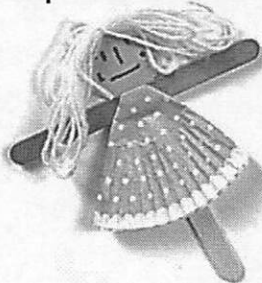

MAKE YOUR CAR LAST A LIFETIME

- Long “warm-ups” on cold days, beyond half a minute, just encourage engine gunk.
- Do drive a cold car slowly at first, letting the engine get fully lubricated. This step alone greatly reduces wear and tear – but almost no one does it.
- Don’t leave stuff in your trunk for “convenience” – the drag can cut your engine’s efficiency by 2% for every 100 pounds.

Find a good mechanic and tell him/her your goal. You can get reviews from auto shop customers in your area at the Mechanics Files section of CarTalk.com.

SAVE YOUR LUNGS

By choosing the right furnace filter, you can keep your lungs clear, and your heating and AC running better. Filters remove pollution and microbes that cause allergies, sickness, even lung damage. But how much they catch depends on their “MERV rating” – the higher the number from 1 to 16, the less gunk gets through.

A MERV lower than 5 won’t remove mold or other threats, but a MERV higher than 12 blocks enough air to raise your power bill.

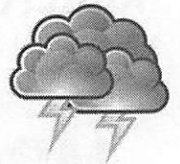
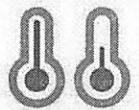
An old or underpowered system needs a MERV of 5-8. A newer system can take a MERV of 9-12. Check the filter monthly when in use, because a clog uses more energy.

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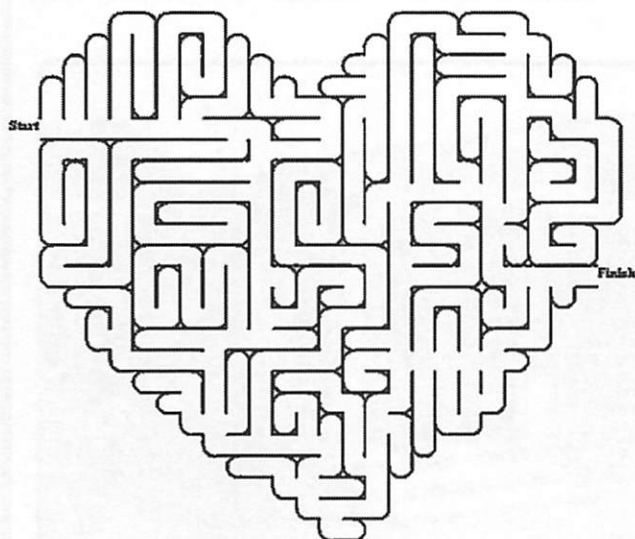

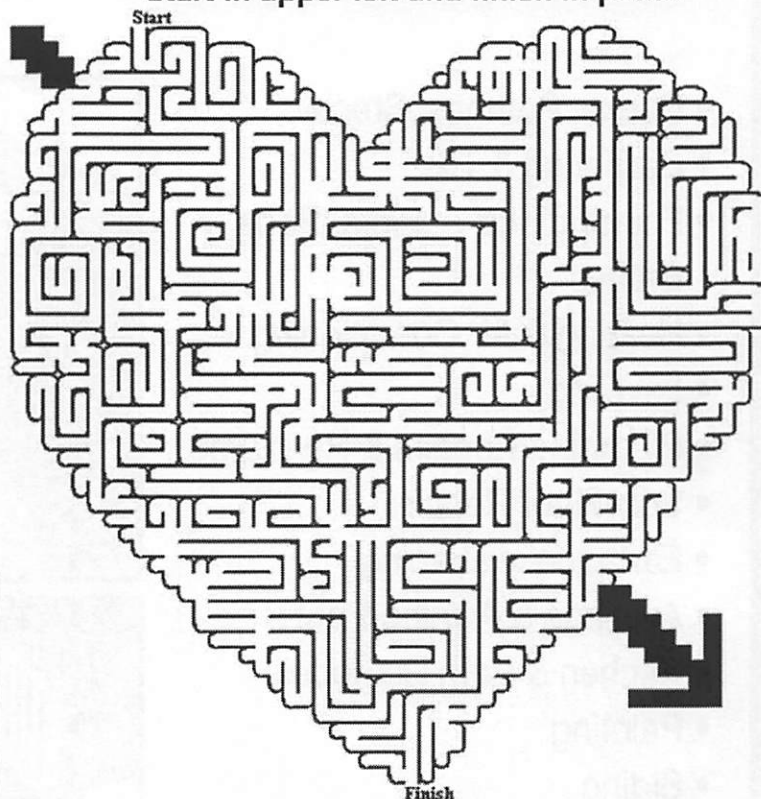
EASY HEART MAZE

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SPRING STARTERS

"Tête-à-tête" is one of the first early-season daffodils to emerge, coming up even with snow on the ground. Early spring is the same time crocus tulip blooms in magenta. Plant it along a walkway or at an entry in full sun, where it's easy to pause and peer down into the yellow centers.



'Persian Pearl' crocus tulip (*Tulipa humilis*) bulb; magenta with yellow centers in early spring; full sun; 4-6 in. tall and 3-5 in. wide.

In addition to full sun, choose a planting spot with good drainage, and you'll encourage both of these easy naturalizers to

spread. Though there's not much of it, do leave the crocus tulip foliage standing once flowers finish, just as you do with daffodil leaves. This way, bulbs can gather plenty of energy for next spring.

'Tête-à-tête' daffodil (*Narcissus* hybrid) bulb is a miniature with bright yellow blooms in early spring; full sun to part shade; 4-10 in. tall and 4-6 in. wide.

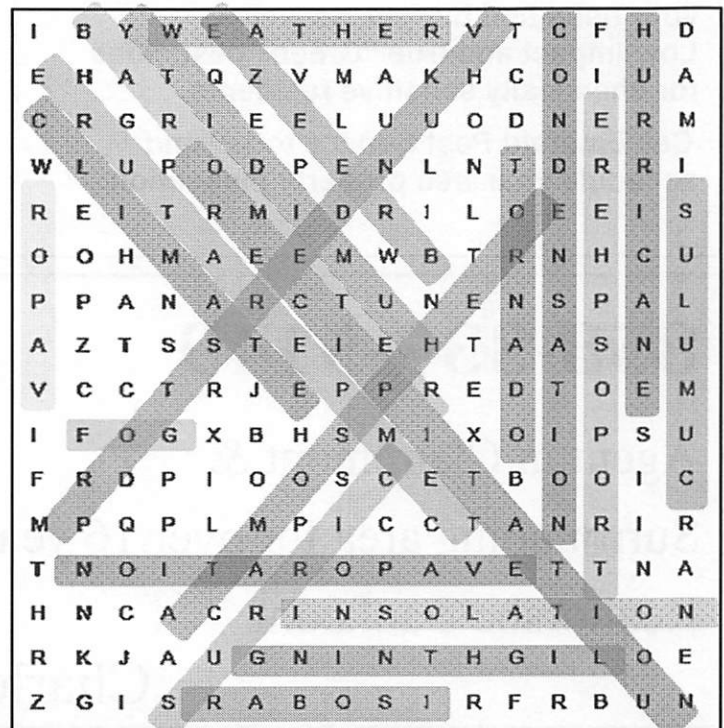
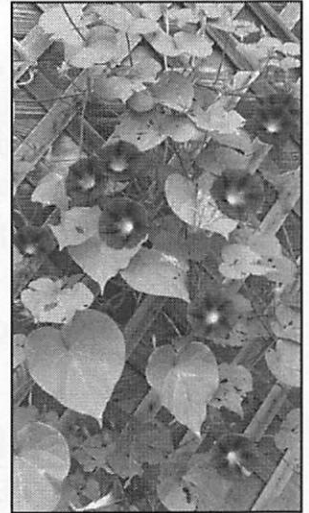

IS IT A WEED

OR A FLOWER?

Keep in mind that a weed is just a plant out of place. Even good plants are deemed weeds if they're unwanted in your garden. If a plant fits any or all of these descriptions, you may have a weed:

- It has multiplied considerably since last year.
- It has sprouted throughout the bed and surrounding lawn.
- It has been in the garden for a few years, never seems to bloom, and has unimpressive foliage. (But remember: Perennials and biennials do not bloom in the first summer, and some plants need a few years to establish and flower, so it may be a plant you want to keep.)
- You don't like it. Once you decide a plant must go, keep the aggressive ones out of your compost pile or they will return. Dispose of them as recommended. If it is just a matter of taste, find a gardener willing to take "that plant" off your hands.

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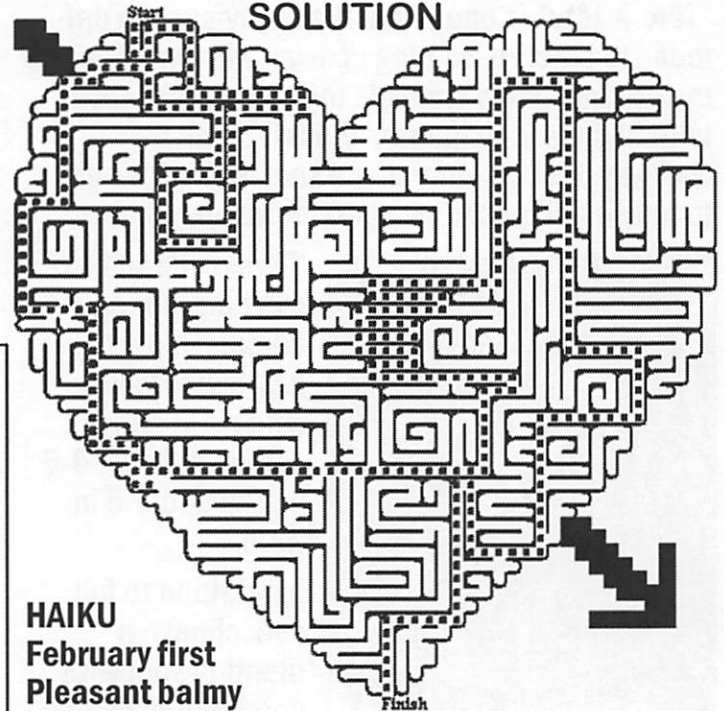

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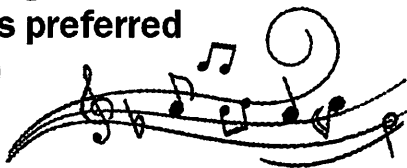

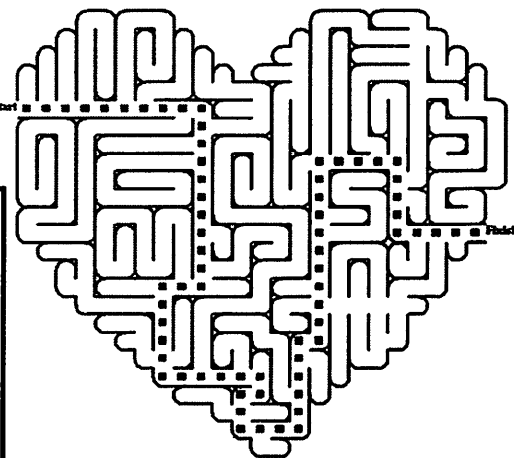
