Have you been frustrated with trying to find a book in the K. L. Library? Take another look!

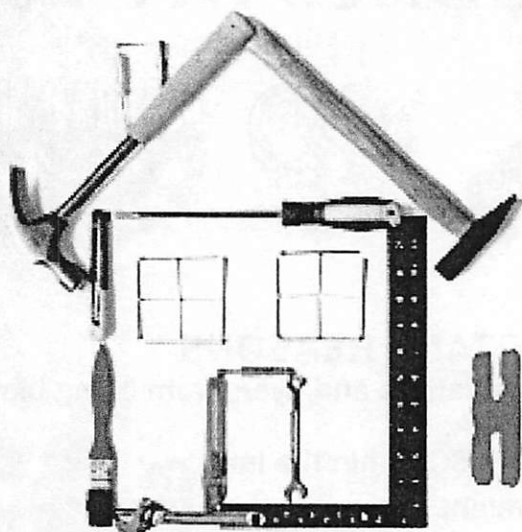

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2015 IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

ALREADY STARTED: Fencing of the Dog Walk area next to Hickman Field Drive. The purpose of the project is to prevent dumping of trash and other items in the Dog Walk area next to the wooden Park fences behind the homes on East Street. The gate next to the Laundry and overflow parking area will remain in place. There will be another gate added at the south-east end of the Dog Walk area closer to Convoy Court. This project is expected to be completed no later than mid-February.

PLEASE NOTE: Dogs are still required to be on leashes. Please remember to pick up excrement from your dog. Bags are supplied at each entry/exit to the Dog Walk.



FUTURE PROJECTS:

- New Washers and Dryers will be installed in both Laundry Facilities by the end of the first quarter (March 31st)
- The Swimming Pool next to the Office and Club House will be drained and resurfaced before the heavy usage of summer.
- Other Maintenance & Upkeep projects will continue to occur throughout the year.

NEW PERENNIALS TO TRY

- **Dark Knight™** sweet alyssum (*Lobularia* hybrid)
This fragrant mix of deep and pale purple
flowers keeps blooming, even as temps rise
from mid-spring to frost, in light full sun to part
shade with moist, well-drained soil. It grows
4 to 6 in. tall by 18 to 24 in. wide
- **Glitterati™** Ice Queen geranium (*Pelargonium*
hybrid) Bright red blooms and white-edged
leaves make this a stunning geranium. It has
excellent heat-tolerance, blooms bright red all
summer in light full sun in well-drained soil,
and grows 4 to 16 in. tall by 10 to 12 in. wide
- **New Day™** Rose Stripe gazania (*Gazania rigens*) Large white
flowers with red stripes bloom
on compact plants with good
drought tolerance in late spring
through summer. It needs light full sun and
well-drained moist soil to grow 8 to 10 in. tall
by 6 to 8 in. wide

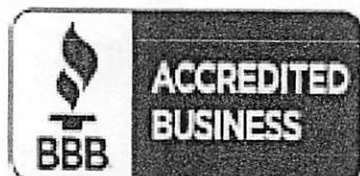

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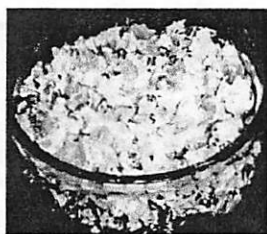
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PECAN CHICKEN SALAD

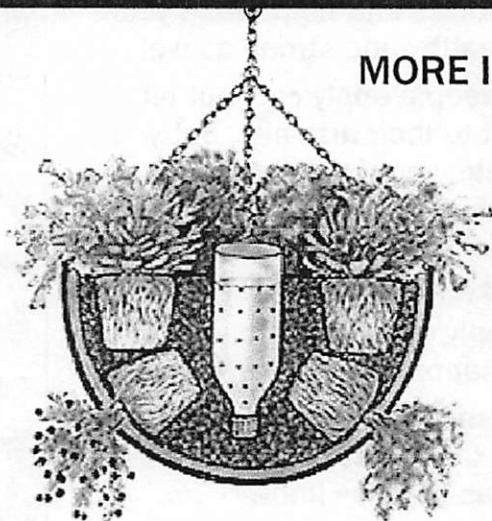
OFFICE/ CLUBHOUSE PARKING
