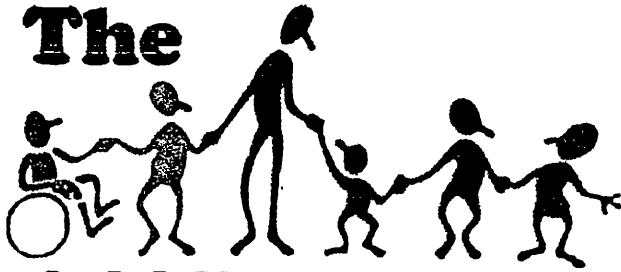

Home-generated "sharps" waste such as hypodermic needles, pen needles, intra-venous needles, acupuncture needles, lancets, and other devices that are used to penetrate skin for the delivery of medication or to conduct a blood test can now be dropped off at locations throughout San Diego.

Remember, California State Law prohibits the disposal of home-generated sharps into any container used for the trash, recycling, or green waste.

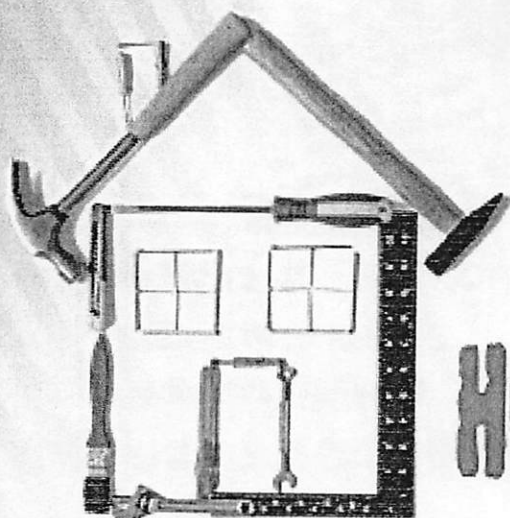

Vice President Dara Dobbins called the meeting to order at 7:14 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The Minutes of the May 2015 meeting were approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT was presented by Nadine Mein and approved.

There may not be another meeting in July because Joe will be gone. It was suggested that a July meeting be held because six people did attend the June meeting without Joe and Joleen. **(NO JULY MEETING)**

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Shuffleboard was cancelled due to lack of interest. Mark Monroe, along with Michelle and Richie, suggested that a "ladder" system be started like at most Tennis Clubs. A list of 5-10 Shuffle-board Players should be listed in order 1-10. To improve your standing, you must challenge a player ahead of you and schedule a time for a match.
2. Mark Monroe asked the status of an updated "Neighborhood Watch list" or Confidential Directory list so we can contact each other in our neighborhood. Nadine mentioned this used to exist in the past but has not been a concern of the Park Management for years.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mark Monroe suggested that instead of trying to hold "Park-wide" Social Events that seem to fail, we should find individuals willing to organize "Block Parties" involving 30-40 Units (or a block): arranging to block off a street area (legally) and having a no-host BBQ/Potluck including organized games. Michelle and Richie volunteered to assist Mark in choosing a date and organize the first one in July or August. Members of the Board will be invited to attend. Perhaps this will slowly increase participation by various neighborhood groups.

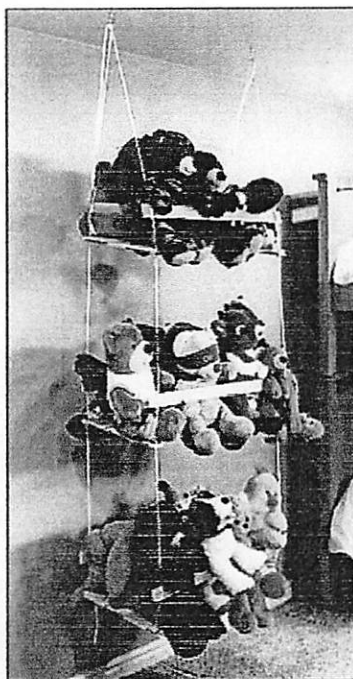

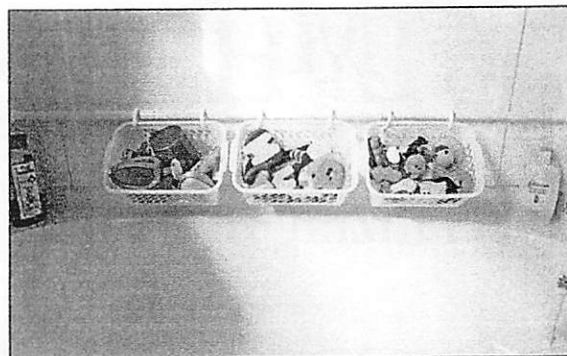
SUMMERTIME TIP

Use cupcake papers to cover drink glasses in the summer and prevent flies and other insects from dropping in.

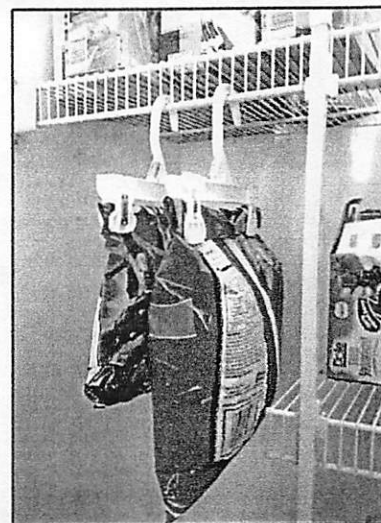

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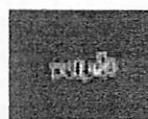
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K. L. PARK GARDEN

Perhaps you've want to be part of the Community Xeriscape Garden project, but you have no plants to contribute. Maybe you could team up with a neighbor, or perhaps you could start now by getting cuttings/ starts ready for Fall planting. With Summer upon us, young plants will have more difficulty getting established, so Fall might be a good time to plant and get better results.

Of course, the area needs to be prepared; maybe ahead of time — rocks cleared, soil broken up and turned, enriched, etc.

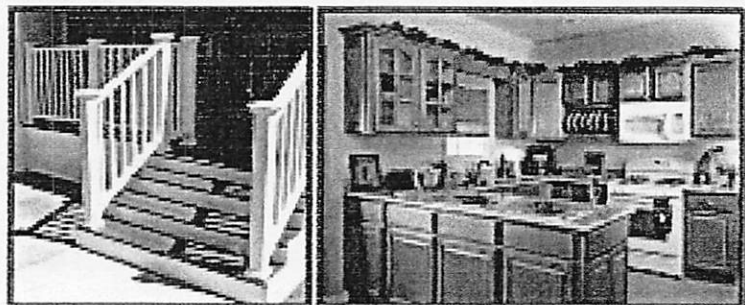
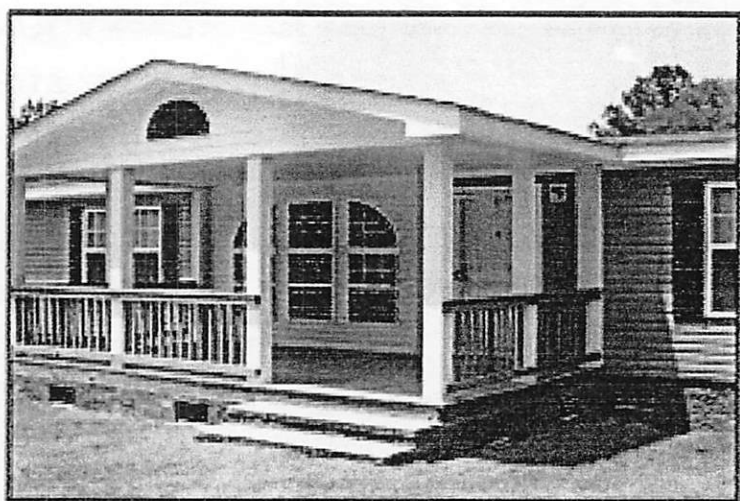

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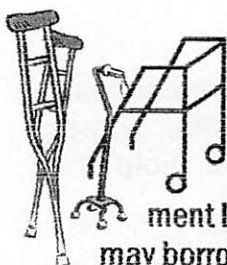

ARRANGE YOUR PLANTERS

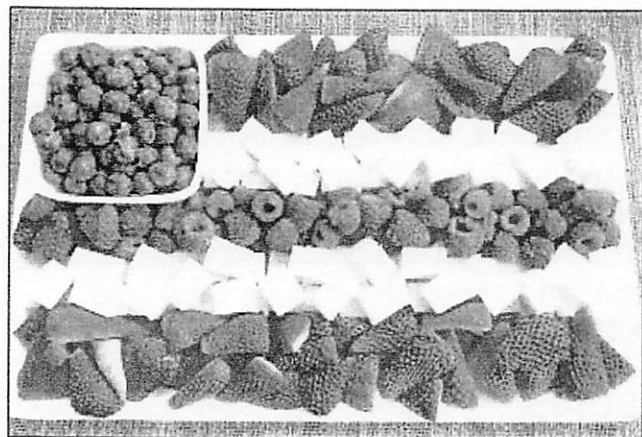
Keeping up with your containers does not have to be a challenge. Consider the arrangement below.

Make watering easier by grouping pots together within reach of the hose. And planting in a large container lets you use more soilless potting mix, so combinations will not dry out as quickly. Adding a layer of bark mulch to the top of the pot helps conserve moisture, too.

Succulents are just right in quick-draining smaller pots. A ring of brick makes trimming around the group easier, and rock mulch helps keep weeds from growing between the smaller pots.

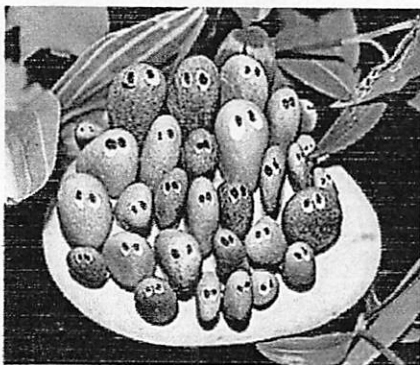

NO-COOK RICE and FRUIT SALAD/DESSERT

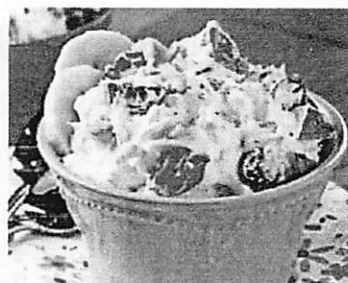
Serves 6

INGREDIENTS:

- 8 oz. cream cheese, softened
- 3 tbsp sugar
- 2 cups cooled cooked rice
- 1 cup red grapes, cut in half
- ½ cup chopped maraschino cherries
- 1 banana, thinly sliced
- 1 (12-oz.) container frozen whipped topping, thawed
- ½ cup chopped walnuts

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. In a large bowl, combine cream cheese and sugar until smooth. Add rice, grapes, cherries, and banana; mix well. Fold in whipped topping and nuts.
2. Chill 1 hour, then serve.

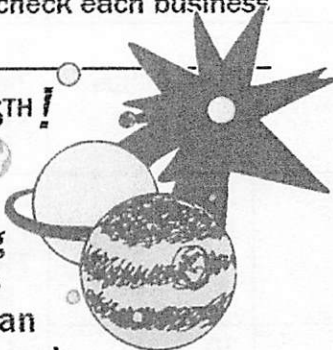
