Have you collected lots of plastic bottle or jug lids just in case they may be useful?

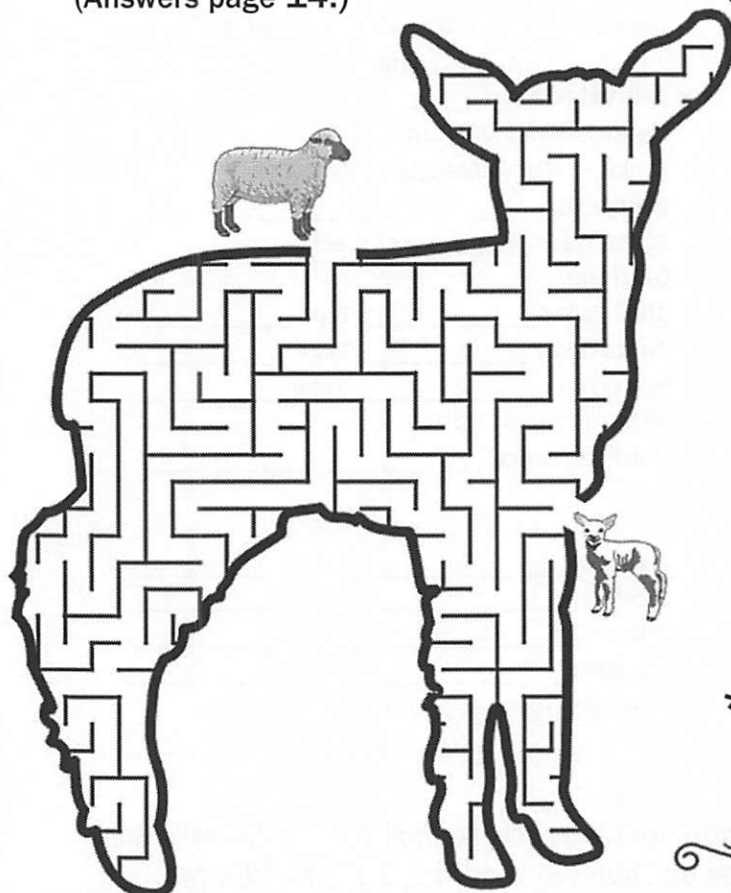
Four lids under a planter make great pot feet. And if you have an iron plant stand, you can

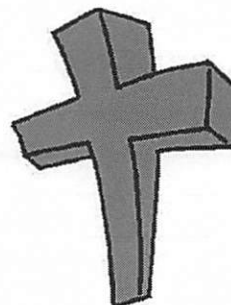

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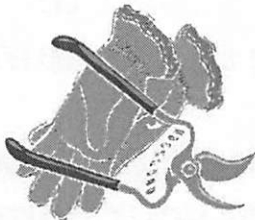

CANDIED CARROTS

INGREDIENTS:

1 lb. carrots, cut into 2-inch pieces
2 tbsps. butter, diced
1/4 cup packed brown sugar
1 pinch salt

INSTRUCTIONS:

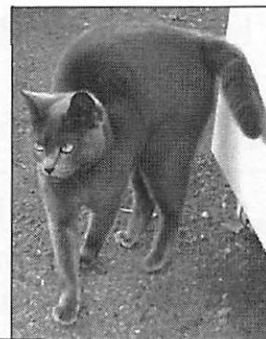
Place carrots in a pot of salted water. Bring water

to a boil, reduce heat to a high simmer and cook 20 - 30 minutes. Do not cook the carrots to a mushy stage! Drain the carrots, reduce the heat to its lowest possible setting and return the carrots to the pan. Stir in butter, brown sugar, salt and pepper. Cook for 3 - 5 minutes, until sugar is bubbly. Serve hot!

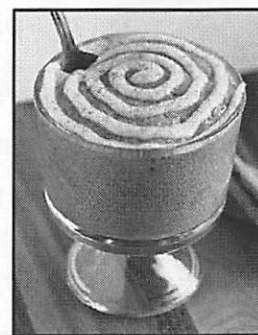


CINNAMON ROLL MUG CAKE

(3 minutes!) 1 Mug Cake.

INGREDIENTS

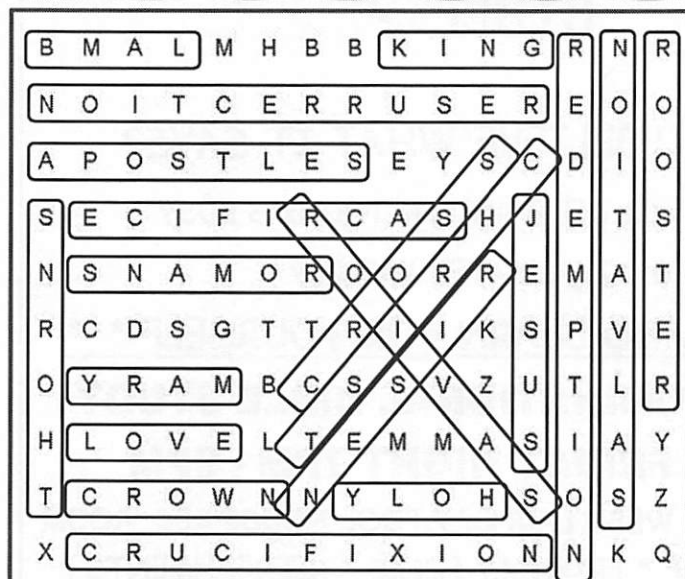
2 Tbsp. applesauce
1 Tbsp. vegetable oil
1 Tbsp. buttermilk
1/4 Tsp. vanilla extract
1/4 cup + 1 Tbsp. all-purpose flour
2 1/2 Tbsp. packed light-brown sugar
3/4 Tsp. ground cinnamon
1 dash ground nutmeg (optional)
1/4 Tsp. baking powder 1/8 Tsp.(scant) salt
1 *Recipe Cream Cheese Icing, recipe follows.*



CREAM CHEESE ICING

1 Tbsp. Cream Cheese or Neufchatel Cheese , softened
2 Tbsp. powdered sugar 1 Tsp. milk

INSTRUCTIONS: Prepare Cream Cheese Icing according to directions listed, set aside. Combine all ingredients (minus Cream Cheese Icing) in a mug, then whisk together with a fork until combine and nearly smooth. Microwave mixture on high power for 1 minute then check cake for doneness. If it is not fully cooked microwave for an additional 15 seconds. Serve warm topped with Cream Cheese Icing.
