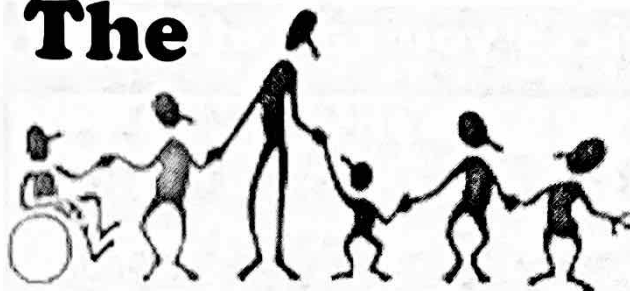

WOW! WEATHER! WISDOM!

This 2019 winter season has been anything but Sun-Diego paradise. Torrential downpour from a "river" in the sky! (atmospheric river). Temperatures low enough to snow-cap the mountains and snow actually falling at just over 1000 feet elevation . . . and hail falling in Kearney Mesa and many other parts of the county. Whipping wind gusts strong enough to uproot trees! And yet, it's all for the best! With more rainfall in the forecast, San Diego County has officially been rescued from "drought" status.

Here in Kearney Lodge, we had one downed tree inhibiting safe street access, in the north-western section of the park. A block captain notified our K. L. Managers after-hours, and without delay, in the rain and wind, the tree was removed from the rain gutter and cut into pieces! (That is the definition of "hands-on!") Similar efforts by the K. L. Maintenance crew and the new security patrol included: clearing debris, managing water drainage and maintaining the safety and security of K. L. residents and their property, throughout the stormy weather.

For the safety and security of your home and property, please check and secure the items and structures around your home, (i.e. integrity of carport, patio furniture, sun blinds, etc., that can be moved/lost by wind), and the trees in your or your neighbor's yard.

Preventative yard maintenance such as pruning plants and tying down items can help reduce loss, ruin and damage. Ensuring proper rain drainage is important since water saturation is above average. Keeping track of local weather forecasts and having a plan for your household in the event of power failure or a natural disaster can make a difference.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICE



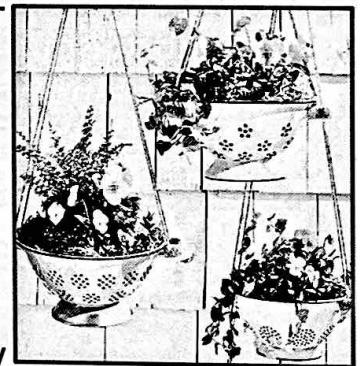
The KLCC Transportation

handle tightly



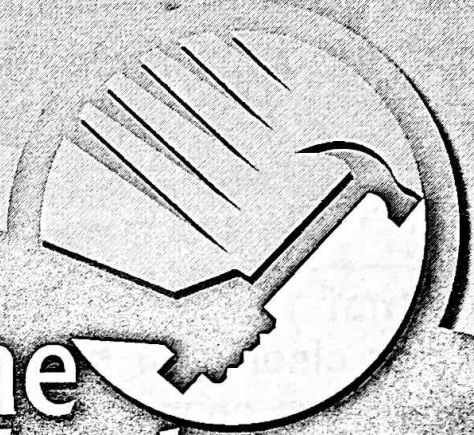
with a half-yard of twine, pushing pieces together as you go to avoid gaps. Once covered, tie off and add a dab of glue to secure. Knot a yard of twine at each end of the handle. Repeat entire process with opposite handle. Next, line the colander with sheet moss and fill with potting soil and seasonal plants. (ferns and pansies shown.) Tie four lengths of twine together and hang where you can enjoy it.

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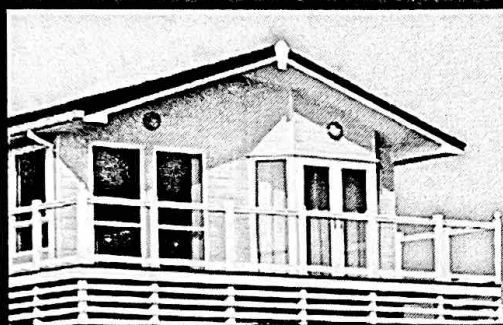
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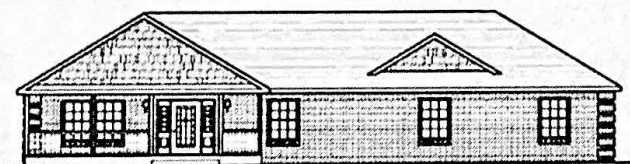
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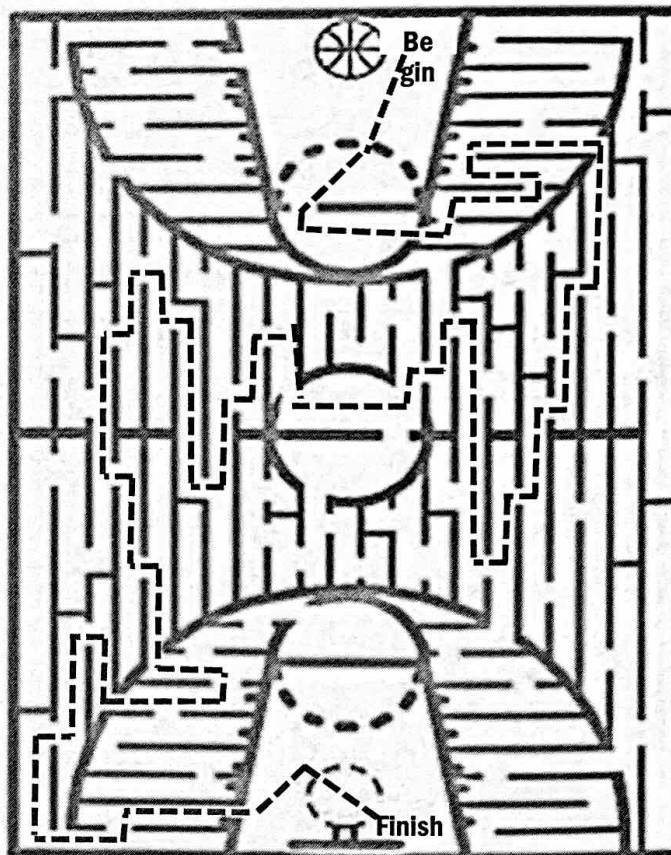
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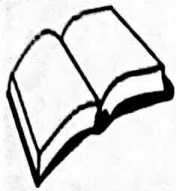
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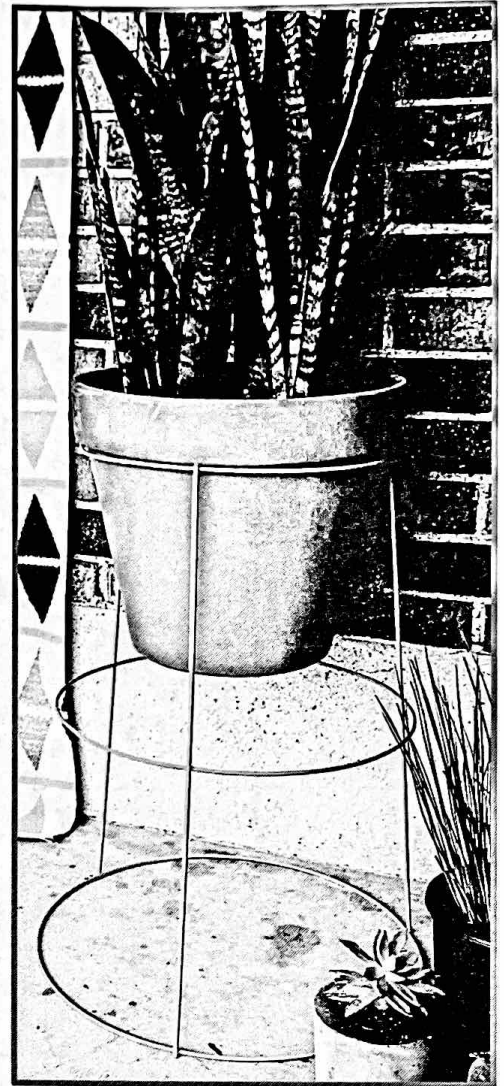
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TOMATO CAGE PLANT HOLDER

This unique large plant holder is simple and inexpensive for patio plants. It allows water to drain through the pots while the plants soak up the sunlight with no obstructions. Just use heavy-duty wire cutters to remove the legs just below the bottom circle as shown in the photo.

SAINT PATRICK'S DAY
