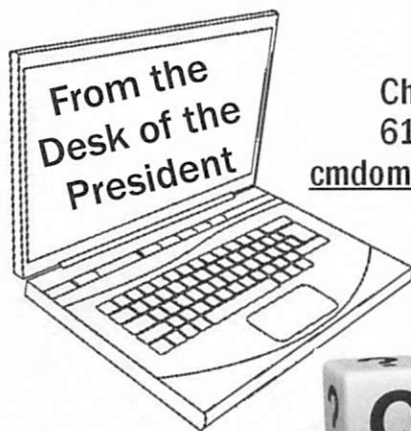

for JULY 2021: # 330**

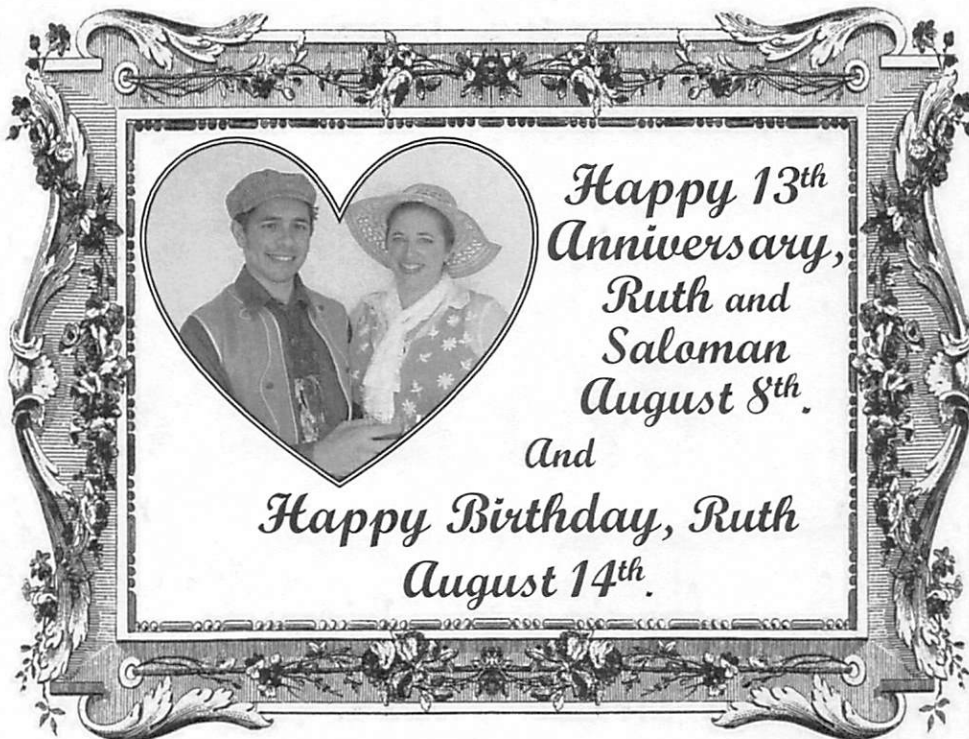

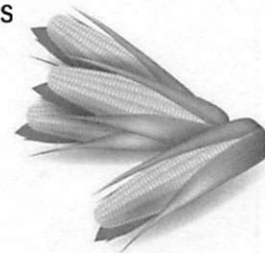

Corn is in season and here is how to fix it.

INGREDIENTS

- 6 large ears yellow corn with husks
- ¼ Cup butter
- ¾ Teas. kosher salt
- ¼ Teas. black pepper
- ½ Cup packed fresh basil leaves
- ½ Cup softened butter
- 2 Teas. fresh lemon juice
- ½ Cup finely grated Parmigiano Reggiano



DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat a gas grill to medium high (400 to 450° F).
2. Working with one ear at a time, grab silks at top of corn with half of silks in each hand. Slowly peel silks down one side at a time, peeling back all silks and husks in one motion. Discard the silks: pull husks together to form a ponytail-like handle. Tear off one small husk piece to use it to tie a knot around the husks to secure.
3. Coat corn with cooking spray and place on grill. Turn occasionally until charred in spots, 15-18 min. Hang husks over the edge of to prevent burning. Remove corn from grill. Wrap individually in foil, excluding husks, placing two pieces of butter on each ear.
4. Process the fresh basil leaves and softened butter and lemon juice in a food processor until smooth.
5. Rub corn with butter mixture and sprinkle with Parmigiano Reggiano.

SLOW-COOKER LEMON RED POTATOES

Makes 6 servings

INGREDIENTS

1-1/2 lbs. medium
red potatoes
1/4 cup water
1/4 cup butter, melted
3 Tbsp. minced fresh parsley
1 Tbsp lemon juice
1 Tbsp minced chives
Salt and pepper to taste



DIRECTIONS

Cut a strip of peel from around the middle of each potato. Place potatoes and water in a 3-qt. slow-cooker. Cover and cook on high until tender, 2-1/2 to 3 hours (do not overcook); drain.

In a small bowl, combine the butter, parsley, lemon juice and chives. Pour over the potatoes and toss to coat. Season with salt and pepper.

TIP: This recipe is versatile and works with any spices you have on hand. You can make up your own combination.

include Sago Palm, Lilies, Dogbane, Foxglove, Milkweed, Kalanchoe, Lily Of The Valley, Oleander, Blue-green Algae, Devil's Ivy, Philodendron, Pothos, Peace Lily, Calla Lily, Dumb Cane, Arrowhead Vine, Mother-in-law's Tongue, Sweetheart Vine, Devil's Ivy, Umbrella Plant, Elephant Ear, English Shamrock: Rhubarb (Leaves), Tropical Star Fruit, Corn Plant/Dragon Tree, Daffodil, Hyacinth, and Tulips.



Remember, if you suspect your pet has sampled a toxic plant, contact your veterinarian, the nearest emergency animal hospital, the ASPCA Animal Poison Control Center at 888-426-4435, or the Pet Poison Helpline at 855-764-7661.

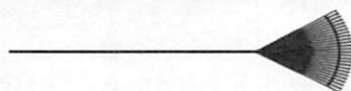

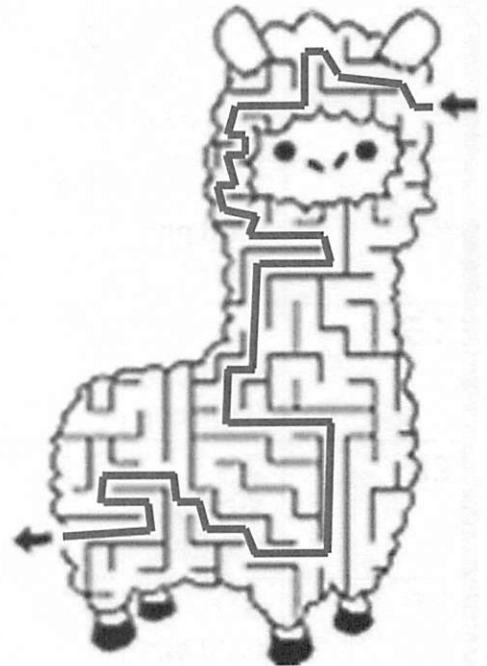
If you experience a theft, no matter how small, call our Police Liaison and let them know. The more they know about what is happening in the Park, the more patrol we will get.

## WORD(S) for the MONTH

'Everyday' vs. 'Every Day'

A simple trick to keep them separate.

They're two of the most-confused words in English. Here's the trick to sort them out.

Choosing between *everyday*, one word, and *every day*, two words, depends on how it is used.

"*Everyday*", one word, is an adjective meaning "used or seen daily," or "ordinary." "The phone calls were an everyday occurrence." "*Every day*," two words, is an adverb phrase meaning "daily" or "every weekday." "They go to the coffee shop every day." One trick to remember which is which is to see if you can put another word between "every" and "day," as in "every single day."

If you can, you want to use the two-word adverb.
