



Self-watering containers make maintaining your plants easier. With a source of water to draw on, plants will stay healthy and good-looking plus save you from dried-out plants. Using a planter that delivers consistent moisture keeps your plants looking lovely without daily watering.

Every couple of days, simply moisten the soil and fill the reservoir with two quarts of water. If you use self-watering *hanging* planters or baskets, be sure to have each on a sturdy hook that's well-anchored because these containers can get extra heavy holding extra water.

#### ORCHID REPOTTING TIPS

With such exotic looks, orchids may seem hard to grow, but that's not true for much of this large



plant family. Some of the most commonly asked questions are about when and how to repot these beauties.

#### KNOW WHEN IT'S TIME TO REPOT

If the plant is overflowing the container or if the potting medium is deteriorating and the roots are packed in, your orchid needs to be repotted. If a bark-based mix is breaking down; it doesn't drain freely when watered; or bits that look like coffee grounds run out with the water; it's time to repot. Most orchids potted in bark mixes need to be repotted every one to three years.

CHOOSE A GOOD MEDIUM AND A PROPER POT Many materials work well for repotting orchids. Sphagnum moss, lava rock, coconut husk chips and bark mix are the most common — just don't use soil. Orchids need good drainage and air movement to their roots, an orchid pot, like in the photo, is the perfect container.

#### CONVERT A COLANDER

Wrap one colander handle tightly with a half yard of twine, pushing pieces together as you go to avoid gaps. Finish

with a dab of glue to secure. Knot a yard of twine at each end of the handle. Repeat entire process with opposite handle. Next, line the colander with sheet moss and fill with potting soil and seasonal plants. (Ferns and pansies shown.) Tie four lengths of twine together and hang where you can truly enjoy your handiwork.

#### **BEAUTIFUL EDIBLES!**

Plant these vibrant edibles and companions where you'll see them often.

This colorful no-fuss combo provides a few greens for fresh salads. Swiss chard takes summer heat better than its companions here. The variety listed below is slow to bolt, or form flowers, which can spoil the taste of the leaves. Ornamental kale is related to the edible kind, but it tends to be bitter; however, it still makes a nice garnish.

Add trailing snapdragons to soften the edges. Plants may start to fade in heat; keep watering, and provide afternoon shade. They most likely will revive as the weather cools.

#### APRIL FOOL'S DAY CUSTOMS


