XERISCAPE PARK GARDEN

Summer is a difficult for young plants to get established, so

Autumn is generally a better time to plant them and get the desired results.

The area needs to be prepared ahead of time—rocks cleared, soil broken up and turned, amendment added, etc. before we plant anything. Maybe neighbors could team up to prepare the space for planting. planning the space could be useful—pathways, use of rocks, placement of different sized plants, planning for their additional growth...

We all could start now by getting cuttings and young/small plants ready for the Fall planting. Hardier varieties that can take full sun all day are the aloes, agaves, dyckias, dudleyas, and sedums.

CROCK POT HAWAI'IAN CHICKEN

Serves: 6-8

Cooking Time: 4-5 hours INGREDIENTS:

- 5-6 boneless chicken breasts or thighs (approx 2 ½ lbs)
- · 16 oz can of pineapple slices, drained



- 1/4 cup corn starch ½ cup brown sugar ½ cup sov sauce 1/4 cup lemon juice
- · 1 tsp ground ginger
- Salt/pepper, to taste preference **DIRECTIONS:**

Spray crock pot with non-stick cooking spray or use liner/parchment. Place chicken in pot. In a mixing bowl, whisk together corn starch, brown sugar, soy sauce, lemon juice, ginger and salt/pepper. Pour over chicken. Next, pour in drained pineapple slices and mandarin oranges. Cover and cook on low for 4-5 hours.


THOUGHTS
