If anyone already has Dish or Direct TV, a special plan is available to facilitate the switch to *UVerse*.



#### **HOW TO MAKE A PAPER SNOWFLAKE**

Real snow flakes have 6 sides.

Supplies: Paper
Pipe cleaners or Ornament hangers
Sharp Scissors (safety type for children.)

1. Start with a

square piece of paper.

Fold the square in half corner to corner so it forms a large triangle. Fold the triangle in half so it makes a smaller triangle. Fold the triangle again. Round the open end of the folded piece of paper so it looks like an eighth of a circle, using the scissors. This is the edge of the paper opposite the point. Trim uneven parts from the bottom.

- 2. Snip designs into the sides. Cut half hearts, half circles, triangles, squares on the edges. Unfold the paper and you have a snowflake.
- 3. Bend a pipe cleaner to form a hook and place the snowflake on it. Bend the top of it to hook on the tree, or use wire ornament hangers.

TIPS: To make a square piece of paper, take a piece of printer paper and

diagonally fold one of the short edges to line up with one of the long edges. Trim the extra strip of paper that isn't part of the two layers of the folded portion.

Punch a small hole in the top of the one of the arms of the snowflake and hang the flake from the ceiling with fishing line or dental floss to create your own indoor snowstorm.
