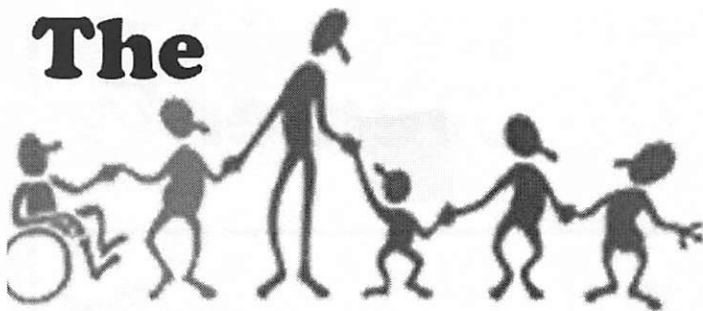

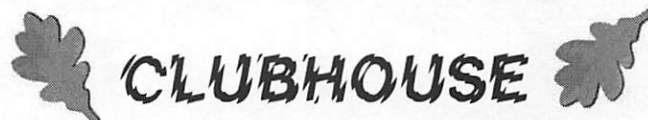

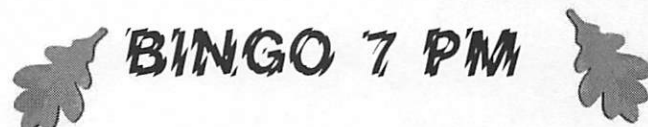

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FROM THE DESK OF YOUR PRESIDENT:

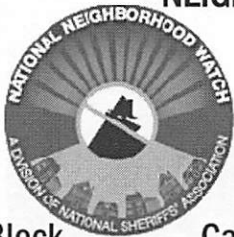
With the year coming to an end it's time to start thinking who will be on the Kearney Lodge Community Connection Board of Officers for 2018.

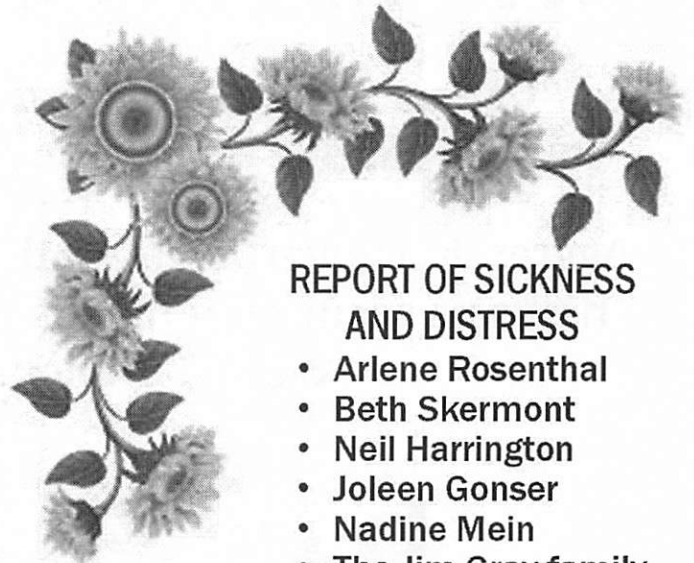
WORDS THAT CONFUSE US:

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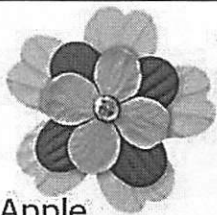

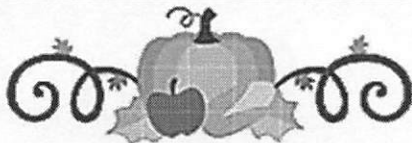

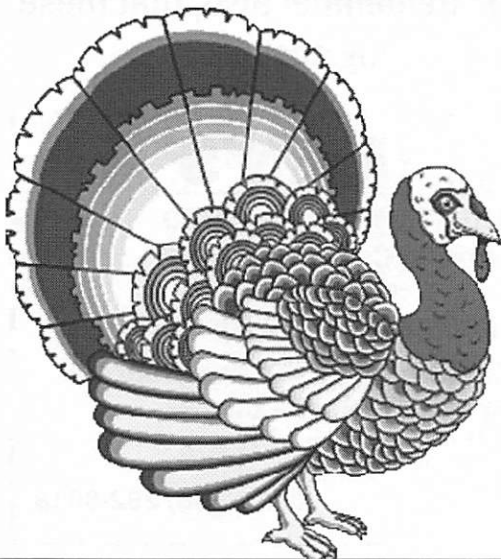
They had a wonderful time. He stays for breakfast. The next morning, she cooks a gourmet meal with all the trimmings. The guy is amazed.

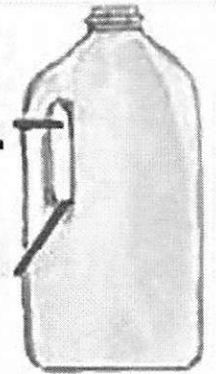
SPLASH-FREE WATERING

Many fuzzy-leafed plants, such as African violets, don't like water on their leaves because wet leaves can spot and also develop fungus.

Make a simple funnel from the handle of a plastic jug to get the water past the leaves directly to the roots.

As shown in the photos, make two cuts on the jug; one near the top, just below the curve, and the other where the handle flares out to attach to the body of the jug. The process is easy enough to make one for each of your plants.

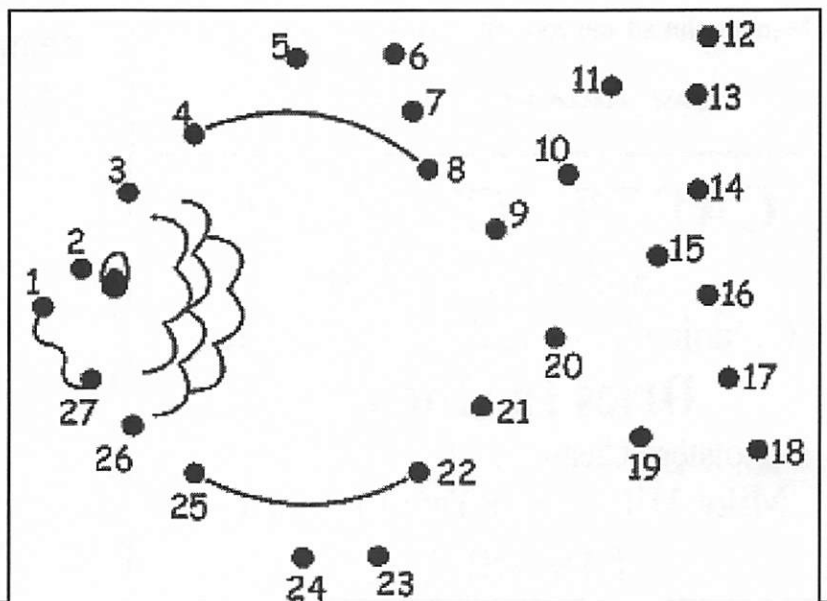
The funnels also make finding the hole in a planter reservoir easier when left in place.
