Hot Meat Hor D'oeuvres  
1 LB lean Ground Beef  
1 LB Hot Jimmie Dean Sausage  
1 LB Velveta Cheese  
Cocktail Rye  
Brown beef and sausage. Drain. Crumble velveta cheese into meat mixture and stir until melted. Spread on cocktail rye. Freeze  
Bake 400 8-10 minutes or until bubbly.

Shrimp Toasties  
12 slices White Bread crust removed  
1 LB raw Shrimp  
¼ Cup finely chopped Onion  
2 TSP Salt  
1 TSP Sugar  
1 egg  
1 TBL Cornstarch  
1 5 oz can Water Chestnuts diced  
Bread Crumbs  
Oil for frying  
Chop shrimp very fine, add onions, salt, sugar, cornstarch,  
and water chestnuts. Beat the egg and stir into shrimp mixture. Spread on bread slices, cut into 4 pieces. Cover shrimp pieces with fine bread crumbs. In 375 oil cook shrimp side down first until edges of bread turn brown, turn and cook to golden brown. Drain on paper towels. May be frozen and reheated in oven.
