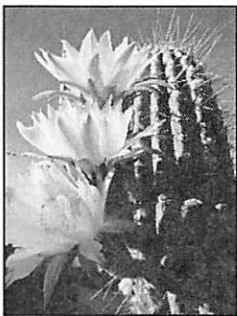
We look forward to continuing to get to know all of you and growing a community we all love! Keep an eye out for more events and opportunities coming soon.

Maybe they/you inherited their/your home and never got a title or registration notice. Maybe they/you thought the purchase receipt of their/your home was proof of ownership and did not realize they/you are responsible for having the home titled in their/your name under California law.

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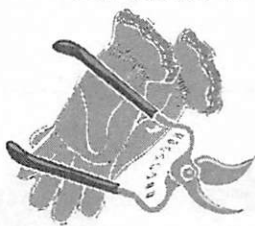
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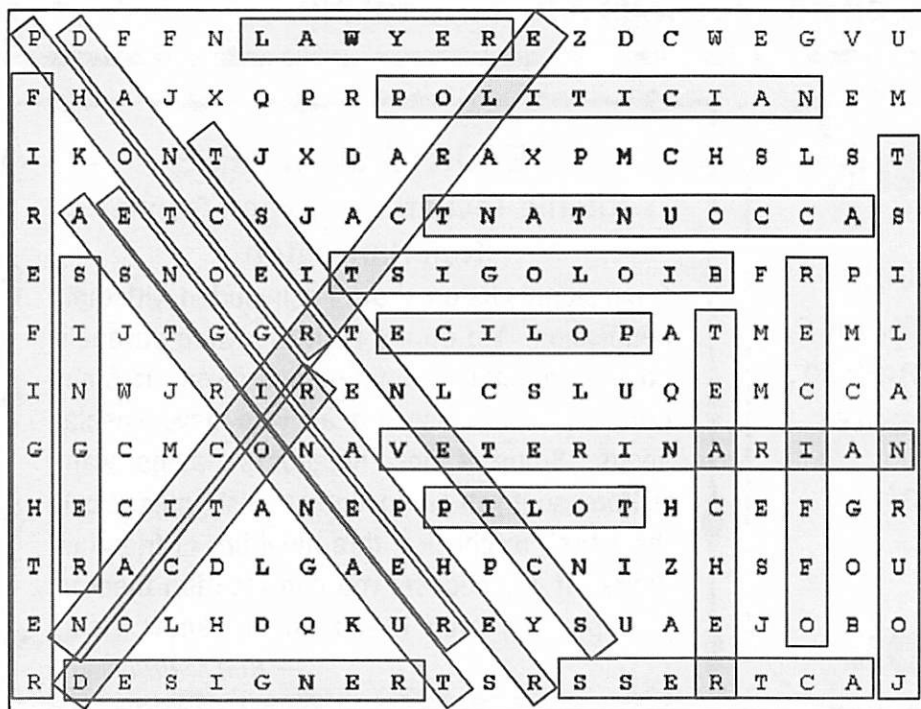
PLEASE LET US KNOW
