2010 CENSUS TO BEGIN

WARNING: 2010 Census Cautions from the Better Business Bureau: Be Cautious About Giving Info to Census Workers by Susan Johns. With the U.S. Census process beginning, the Better Business Bureau (BBB) advises people to be cooperative, but cautious, so as not to become a victim of fraud or identity theft. The 2010 U.S. Census is under way as workers have begun verifying the addresses of households across the country. Eventually, more than 140,000 U.S. Census workers will count every person in the United States and will gather information about every person living at each address including name, age, gender, race, and other relevant data.

The big question is - how do you tell the difference between a U.S. Census worker and a con artist? The BBB offers the following advice:

* If a U.S. Census worker knocks on your door, they will have a badge, a handheld device, a Census Bureau canvas bag, and a confidentiality notice. Ask to see their identification and their badge before answering their questions. However, you should never invite anyone you don't know into your home.

* Census workers are currently only knocking on doors to verify address information. Do not give your Social Security number, credit card or banking info to anyone, even if they claim they need it for the U.S. Census.

REMEMBER, NO MATTER WHAT THEY ASK, YOU REALLY ONLY NEED TO TELL THEM HOW MANY PEOPLE LIVE AT YOUR ADDRESS. While the Census Bureau might ask for basic financial information, such as a salary range, **YOU DON'T HAVE TO ANSWER ANYTHING AT ALL ABOUT YOUR FINANCIAL SITUATION.** The Census Bureau will not ask for Social Security, bank account, or credit card numbers, nor will employees solicit donations. Any one asking for that info is NOT with the Census Bureau.

Eventually, Census workers may contact you by telephone, mail, or in person at home. The Census Bureau will not contact you by Email, so be on the look-out for Email scams impersonating the Census personnel.

Never click on a link or open any attachments in an Email supposedly from the U.S. Census.

RACCOONS IN KEARNEY LODGE!

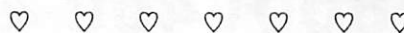

Smokey had to take the series of Rabies shots, and now is reported as doing fine.

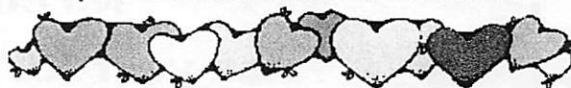

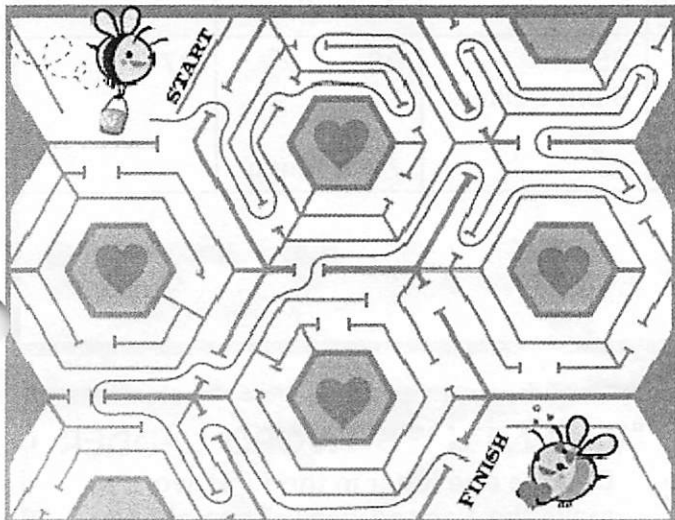
STRING OF HEARTS



Valentine's Day craft

Materials: Paper Scissors Markers
Cookie Cutter and Glue (both optional)

Instructions: Cut out a strip of paper that is about 18 by 2 ½ inches, and fold it accordion style in 2 ½ inch sections. On the top layer, draw a heart, or tracing a heart cookie cutter. Remember, just as with a paper-doll chain, the sides of the heart must extend to the folded edges. Cut through all the layers of paper except where the sides touch the fold. Decorate the hearts with markers or glue on bits of paper, beads or glitter.

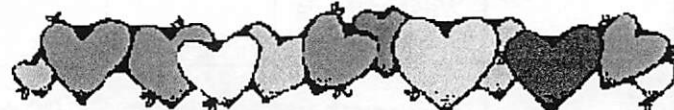
