The bilby is a small (2 to 5.5 lbs.), shy mammal with big ears, which is native to Australia and an endangered species. It is possible to buy chocolate Easter bilbies and some of the profits go to help preserve these animals.

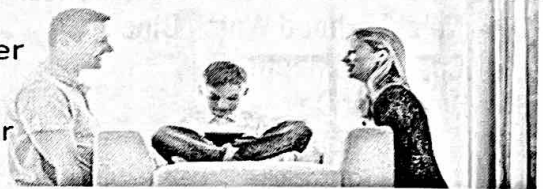

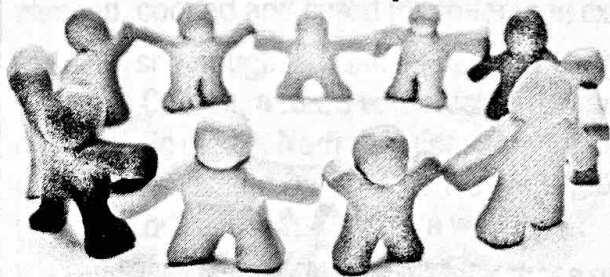

## WHY DO EASTER AND PASSOVER DATES CHANGE EACH YEAR?

Easter, which celebrates Christ's return from the grave following his crucifixion, can occur on any Sunday between March 22 and April 25.

Easter's date is set to coincide with the vernal equinox, a day when the sun shines directly on the equator, and the majority of Earth experiences nearly equal hours of sunlight and nighttime, which signals the start of spring in the Northern Hemisphere.

Because Christ's death and resurrection happened after the Jewish Passover, which is celebrated on the first full moon after the equinox, early Christians wanted Easter to always take place following Passover, according to *ThoughtCo*.

To make a long answer short, Easter falls on a different date each year because it, like Passover, is tied to solar and lunar cycles.

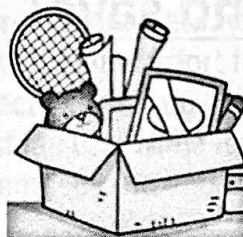

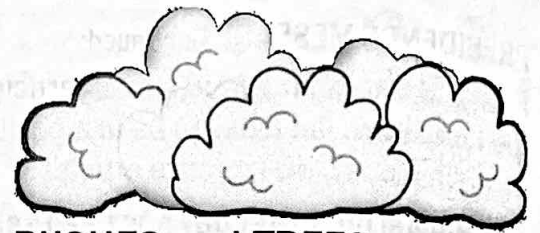
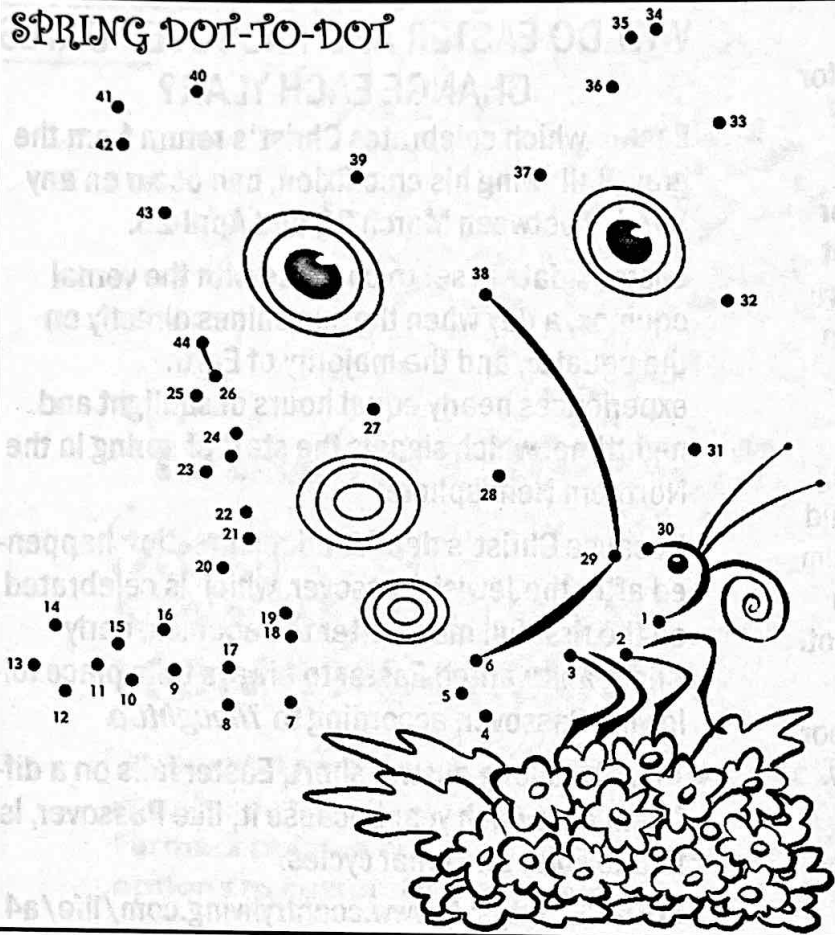

### Nadine Mein

Nadine Amanda Mein was born December 12, 1928.

Second of four daughters raised on a family farm in Cole Camp, MO, she moved away after schooling and began a life-long career in bookkeeping. She met her dear husband, Orville "Eddy" Mein during his military service and they married on May 28, 1949.



By 1954, with three children, Carolyn, David and Wayne, the Mein family moved to Kansas City, KS. With Orville's natural ability for mechanics, he quickly gained employment. Within a short time however, Orville's new job began layoffs which resulted in weeks of unemployment. Living off commmeal cakes and mashed potatoes, and down to the last bottle of baby formula, the couple prayed for God's help. Orville told Nadine, "Don't worry. Just as God told Elijah, 'I have commanded the ravens to bring you food.' He will send the ravens to feed us!" For the next week, every morning, Orville opened the kitchen window and one day the ravens came in the form of a United States post man who delivered a check for \$900!

The Mein family continued to live by faith and hard work until the early passing of Orville in 1973. In 1984, Nadine moved to San Diego to be close to her daughter, Carolyn. She lived in a friend's home where she cleaned, cooked and cared for children in exchange for room and board.

In 1986, she bought a home in Kearney Lodge Mobile Home Park. A devoted patron of Reformation Lutheran Church, a KLCC volunteer as Treasurer, (1994 through 2018), and still working in her daughter's chiropractic office, Nadine is considered a pillar of the Clairmont Mesa community. She has two grandchildren, Kathy and David, and five great-grandchildren. She can be seen riding her red tricycle around Kearney Lodge a couple times a week.

We celebrate Nadine Amanda Mein; those of us who know her well, consider her a TREASURE!

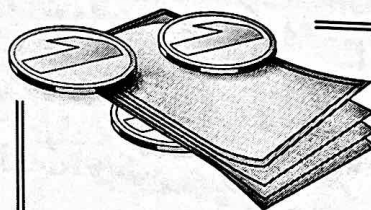
### RSVP SEEKS VOLUNTEERS

need of a Treasurer since Demi Woodson has resigned due to scheduling conflicts.

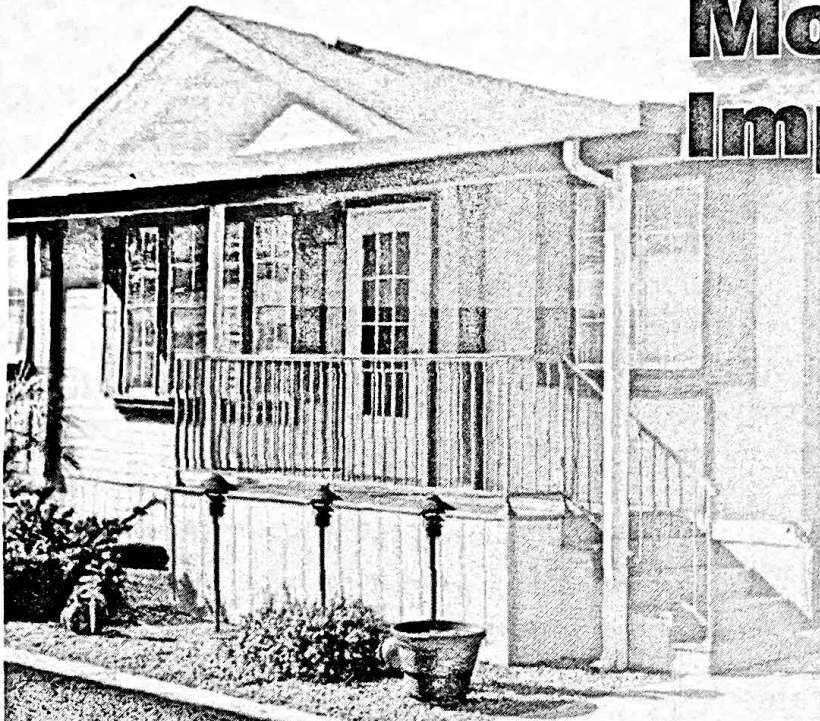
