
Kearney Lodge Resident Complaint Form

Flag Day



Flag Day is a celebration of the adoption of the American flag by Continental Congress in the First Flag Resolution of June 14, 1777. Although the 200-year anniversary of this date was celebrated by flying flags on public buildings and holding remembrances in several cities, Flag Day wasn't officially

recognized until President Harry Truman signed it into law in 1949.

Bernard J. Cigrand, known to the general public as the "Father of Flag Day," worked as a school teacher at Stony Hill School in Waubeka, Wisconsin. He held the first unofficial observance for Flag Day at that school in 1885, and today a bust of Cigrand stands in Waubeka at the National Flag Day Americanism Center.



May 2017




Stephen Dexter Owner Space # 1


Retired Senior Volunteer Patrol (RSVP)

The Retired Senior Volunteer Patrol program is a vital, indispensable component of the San Diego Police Department. It began in 1992 as a pilot program in Rancho Bernardo. Today we are over 400 strong and growing all the time. To give you an idea of how much they do, since January 2013, the R.S.V.P.'S donated almost 53,000 hours to patrol and other city events. They are on pace to hit 125,000 in volunteer hours by the end of the year.

RSVP'S donate many valuable services for the communities in which they serve. Among these are vacation house checks;

- child fingerprinting programs
- · gathering evidence
- visiting elderly persons living alone
- and various crime prevention duties.


