RUMMAGE SALE REMINDER

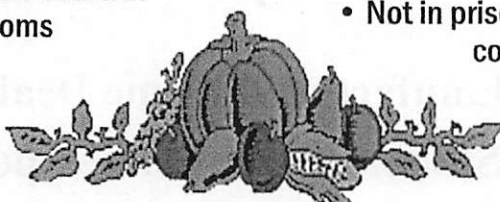

- A U.S. Citizen
 - A California Resident
 - At least 18 years of age on or before the next election
 - Not in prison or on parole for a felony conviction
 - Not declared mentally incompetent by court action
- It is our privilege and responsibility to vote.

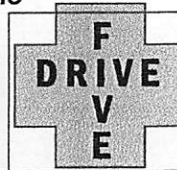

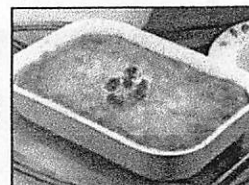

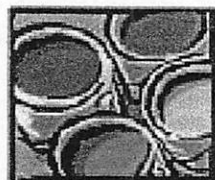

JIFFY CORN PUDDING



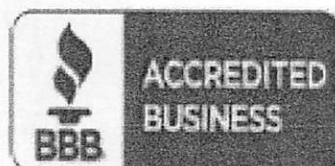
1 box of Jiffy cornbread mix

SMART STAKE STORAGE

To store plant stakes neatly over the winter, just slide them into a leftover tree-trunk wrap or even a paper towel tube, similar to the photo. 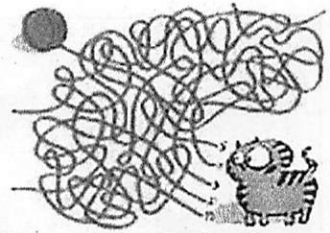

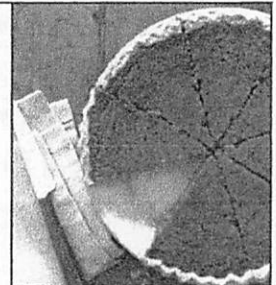
SWEET POTATO PIE

Serves 8 — Time 2 hrs
INGREDIENTS

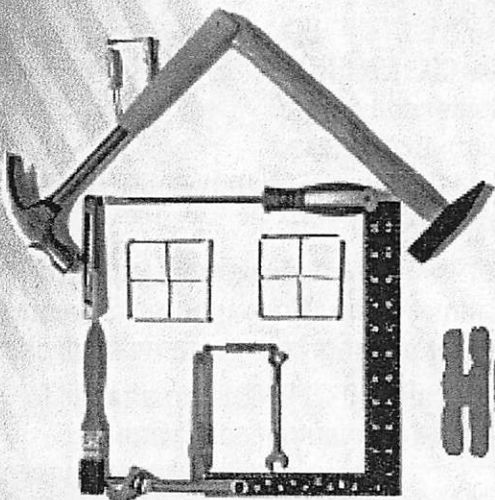
- 2 tbsp unsalted butter,
at room temp.
- 1/3 cup light brown sugar
- 1 tbsp fresh orange juice
- 1 tbsp honey
- 1 large sweet potato, cooked and mashed
- 1/2 12-oz. can evaporated milk
- 1/2 tsp vanilla extract 1/4 tsp salt
- 1/4 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/8 tsp ground nutmeg
- 1 9-inch refrigerated piecrust

DIRECTIONS

1. Heat oven to 350° F.
2. In a large bowl, with an electric mixer on
medium, beat the butter and sugar for 3
minutes. Add the egg, orange juice, and
honey and beat for 2 minutes. Add the
sweet potato, evaporated milk, vanilla, salt,
cinnamon, and nutmeg and combine.
3. Pour the sweet potato mixture into the crust.
Bake until the filling is set, 50 to 60 minutes.
Let cool for at least 30 minutes. Serve at
room temperature.

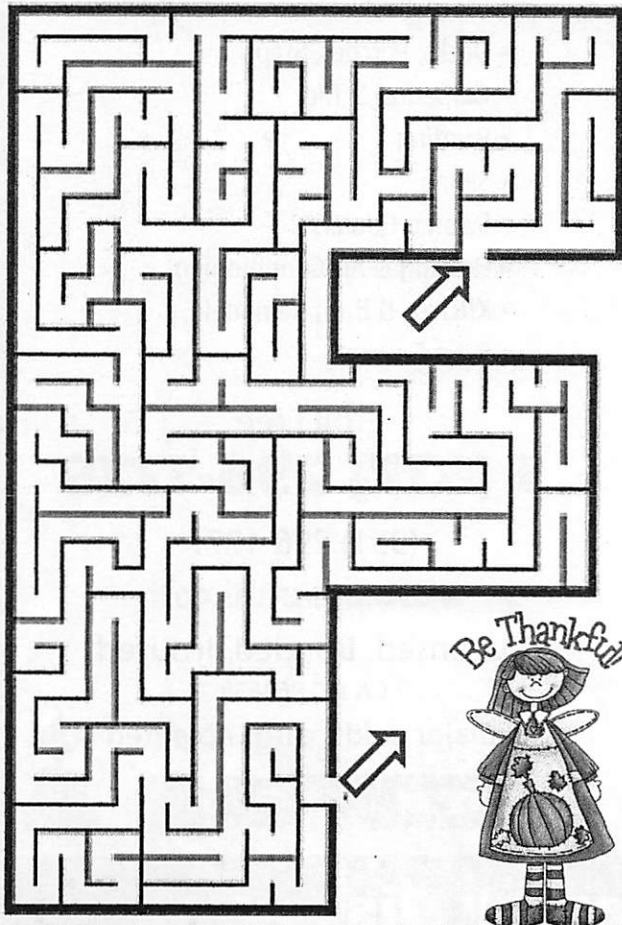

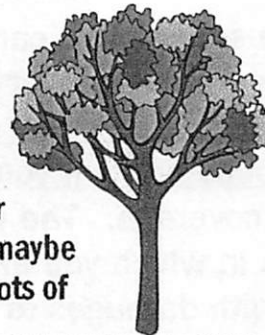
Like them, but they aren't on my regular grocery list.

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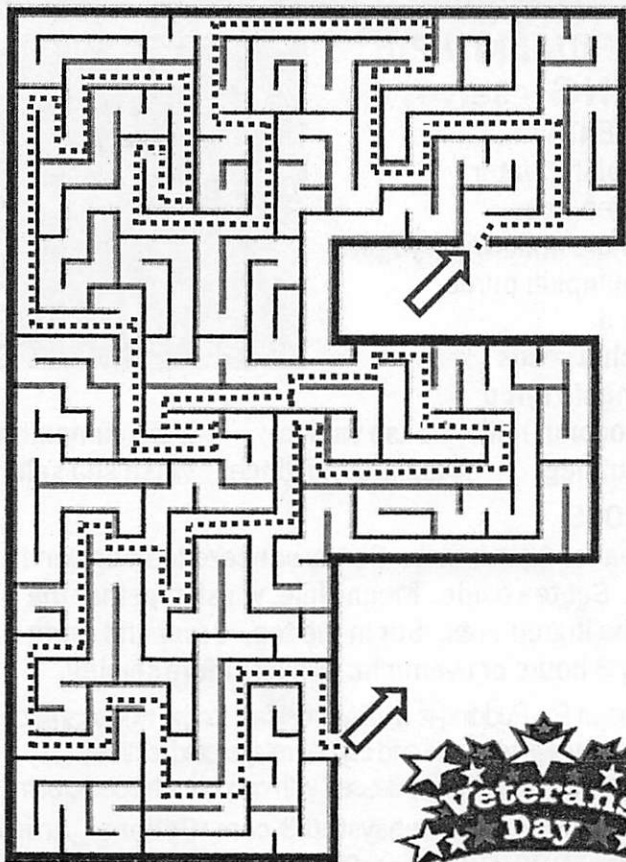
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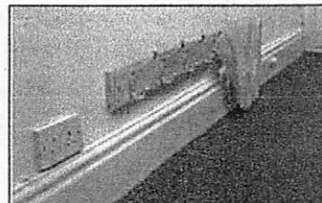

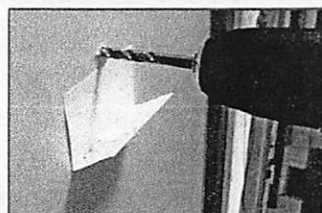

CHIA PUMPKIN PIE PUDDING - Serves 4

INGREDIENTS

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup boiling water

3 green tea bags

1 cup whole milk Greek yogurt

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup pumpkin puree,
canned

$\frac{1}{3}$ cup chia seeds

$\frac{1}{4}$ cup maple syrup

$\frac{1}{4}$ cup coconut milk 1 tsp vanilla 2 tsp cinnamon

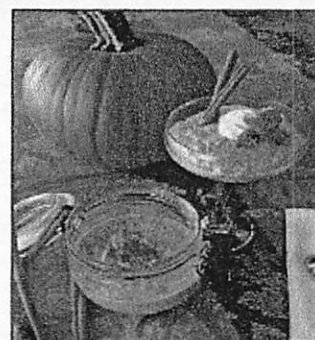
$\frac{1}{8}$ tsp nutmeg $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp ground ginger $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp sea salt

DIRECTIONS:

Steep tea for 10 minutes. Gently squeeze tea bags and discard. Set tea aside. Meanwhile, whisk together the rest of the ingredients. Stir in the tea. Cover and refrigerate for 3 hours or overnight. Whisk before serving.

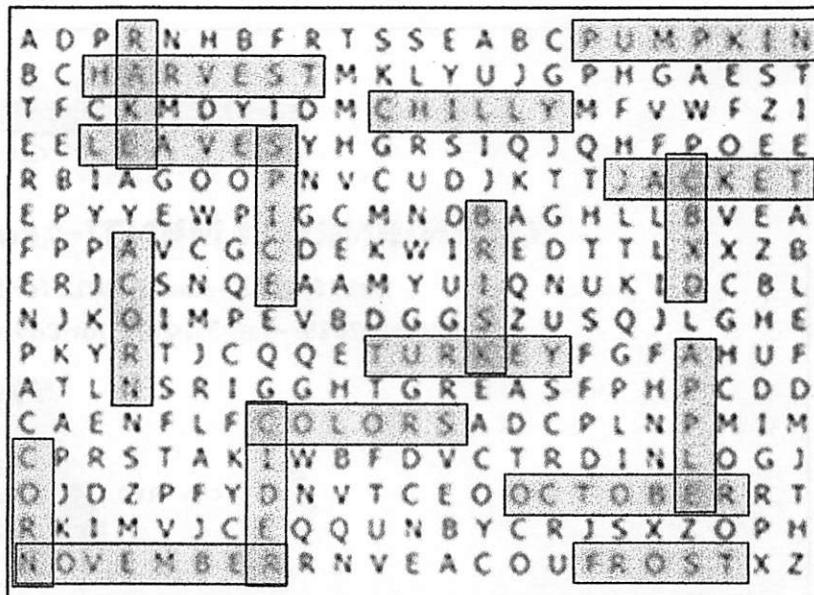
