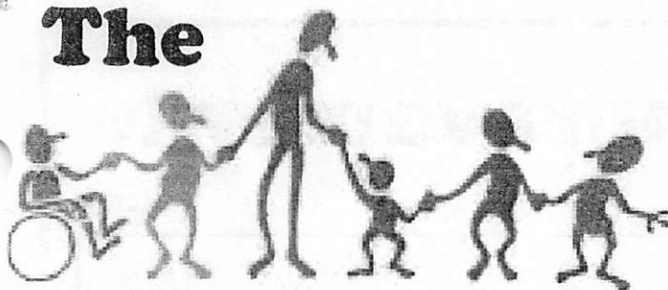

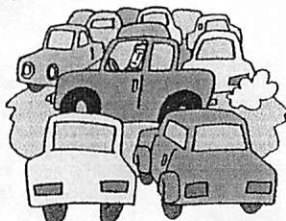

E-waste collection.

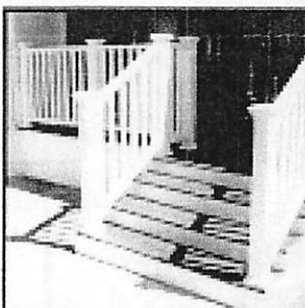
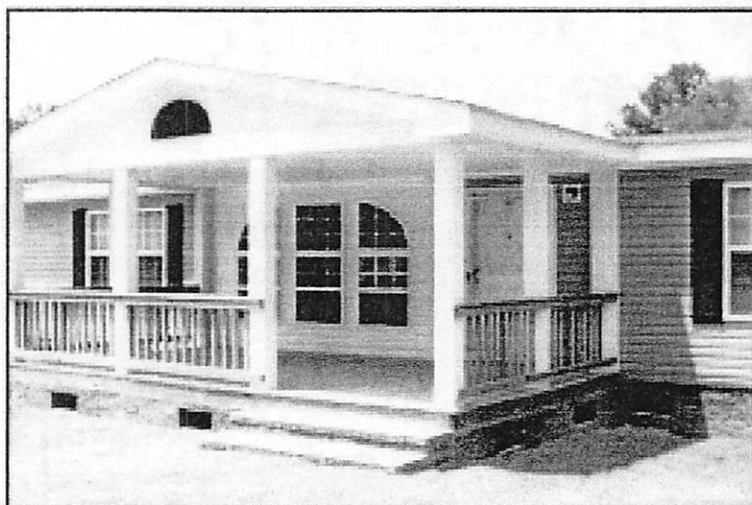

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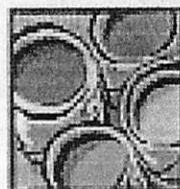
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*If consumer hires an unlicensed contractor for a job over \$500 they have no recourse if the contractor does not perform satisfactorily.

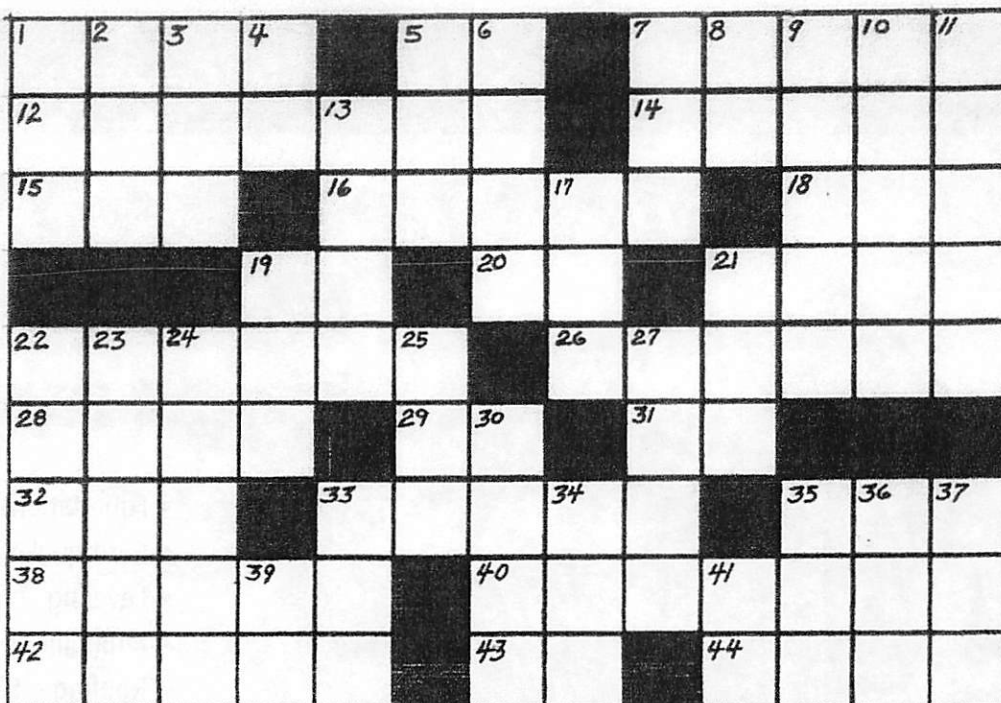

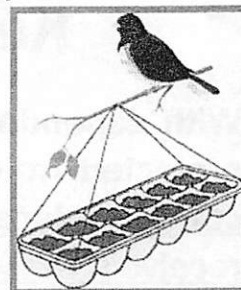
EGG CARTON BIRD FEEDER

TOOLS & SUPPLIES NEEDED:

1. Egg carton bottom
2. Scissors
3. String
4. Birdseed.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Poke holes in the four corners of the egg carton.
- Cut 4 pieces of string (about 1.5 feet each) and knot each at one end.
- Pull a string through each carton hole.
- Gather strings in middle, and knot.
- Fill each egg section with birdseed.
- Hang on a tree and watch the birds feast!

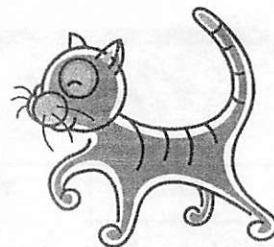

No matter the reason for keeping cats out of your yard, there are effective, humane ways to help them find somewhere else to explore. NOTE: some brand names are included in this compilation, but these are not everything available should you want to buy a cat deterrent.

MOTION-ACTIVATED SPRINKLERS – The easiest way to deal with wandering cats is to make your yard unappealing to them. Because most cats dislike getting wet, you can try using a motion-activated lawn sprinkler, such as the ScareCrow®.

ULTRASONIC DEVICES – Some motion-activated devices, such as the CatStop® automatic outdoor cat deterrent or the Critter Gitter®, but you dogs may hear these too.

NATURAL DETERRENTS – Natural methods can make the ground in your yard unattractive to cats. Many cats love to use a nice flower bed as a toilet. For your garden, try placing chicken wire at ground level or just under the surface of the soil. You can cut holes in the wire to allow your plants to grow. The surface of the ground will be uncomfortable for cats to walk on and make it impossible for them to dig in the dirt. You can also place certain plastics just under the surface of the dirt to frustrate cats who try to dig in your garden. Another alternative is to use natural objects to discourage cats from walking through your planted areas. Prickly pinecones can do the trick, and if you're not fond of these as a permanent feature of your garden, you can simply remove them after you've successfully repelled

visiting cats. Whatever you decide to use, make sure it's not so sharp that it causes injury.



Cat Scat from Gardener's Supply (http://www.gardeners.com/Safe-Cat-Deterrent/31-954_default.pd.html) consists of plastic mats that are pressed into the soil. Each mat has flexible plastic spikes and is cut into four pieces. The spikes are harmless to cats and other animals, but discourage excavation.

Cover exposed ground with rough surfaced rocks.

Lay lattice fencing on the ground prior to planting, then plant flowers and seeds in the openings.

Use Scent repellants. Reports on the effectiveness of scent repellants are mixed. Repellants should be sprayed or placed around the edges of the yard, the top of fences and on any favorite digging areas or plants.

The Coleus Canina plant, a weed originating in Europe, is known as the "Scardy-Cat" or "Pee-off" plant because it emits an odor offensive to cats (but not to humans) and deters their presence. The recommendation is to plant them three feet apart around the area to be protected. You may need to order cuttings or seeds from a nursery or dealer. WARNING: There are many varieties of Coleus plants, so make sure you order the correct one - Coleus Canina.

For protecting gardens or flower beds, common household items may be effective, including the herb rue, either planted or sprinkled in its dry form. Other suggestions for garden areas are orange and lemon peels (cats dislike citrus smells), cayenne pepper, coffee grounds, pipe tobacco, lavender oil, lemon grass oil, citronella oil, peppermint oil, eucalyptus oil, and mustard oil. There are commercial products with combinations of these ingredients available.

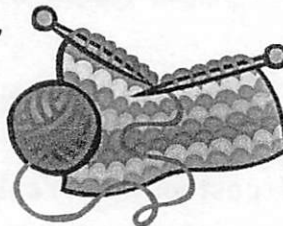
