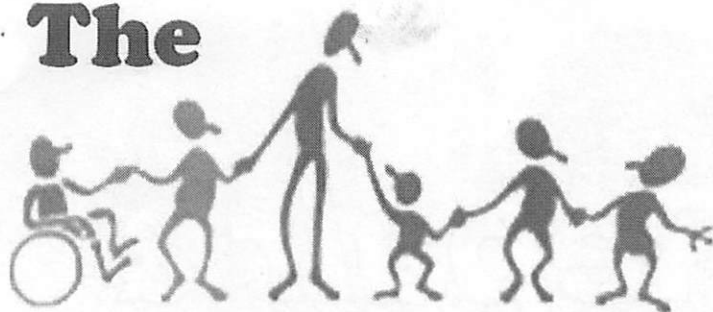

Greetings from the desk of your President:

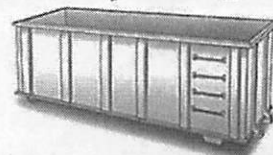
