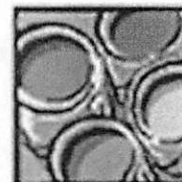

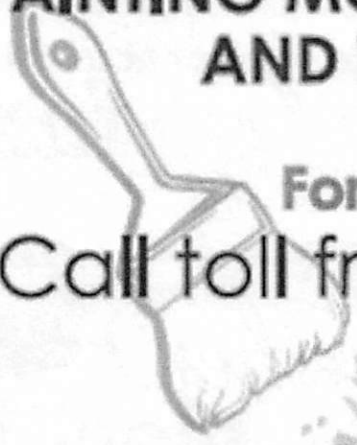

Joe Beatty called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

HOUSEKEEPING CONCERNS:

1. Joe reminded everyone to speak one at a time; raise hands to be recognized.
2. September minutes reviewed and approved as recorded in the Community Connection.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Joleen reported possible new half-page ad coming in November.
2. Ellen took two different residents to doctor appointments
3. Joe's report on rummage sale: it was not as successful as hoped. Maybe more or other advertising needs to be done. Also need to notify sellers earlier to be better prepared. Maybe once-a-year would yield bigger turn out. Leftovers from the KLCC table donated to DAV.
4. Joe asked members to confirm whether or not to continue following Park events;
 - a. Sunday: Shuffleboard postponed until further notice due to lack of attendance. Should individuals or group wish to use the equipment at anytime, they need to contact management.
 - b. Monday: Painters – ongoing at Clubhouse.
 - c. Tuesday: Movie Night – those attending select the movie from a variety of DVDs available. See bulletin board for dates.
 - d. Thursday: Quilters meet at Clubhouse.
 - e. Friday: Bingo at Clubhouse 7 pm except the day after Thanksgiving in November.
 - f. Friday: Non-denominational Bible Study in Pool Room.
5. Joe announced that new stickers for safe driving is still in the works.
6. Regarding Swift Communications: there is no update on what they do and there is no new cable company coming into the Park. The alternatives to this are an antenna, Netflix, Dish Direct, and U-Verse.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. By-laws changed to move election of officers January (as opposed to August) voted upon and approved. Current officers will serve until January 2015. Secretary duties will be performed on a rotating basis until someone agrees, or is elected, to be the permanent secretary for the remainder of this term.
2. San Diego mayoral election is November 19th. As for all elections, if you have moved and had a name change since you last voted, you must re-register. Applications available at the Registrar's office. Steve in space 66 also has some applications available.
3. Joe talked about his "Letter from the President" in the October *The Connector*. All agreed that it was a good presentation. He pointed out how it is important to come to the meetings to voice your opinions and ideas. This is the proper way to be heard. Everyone has this right.
4. Raffle drawing for the \$12.00 that was contributed. Winner's name will not be published.
