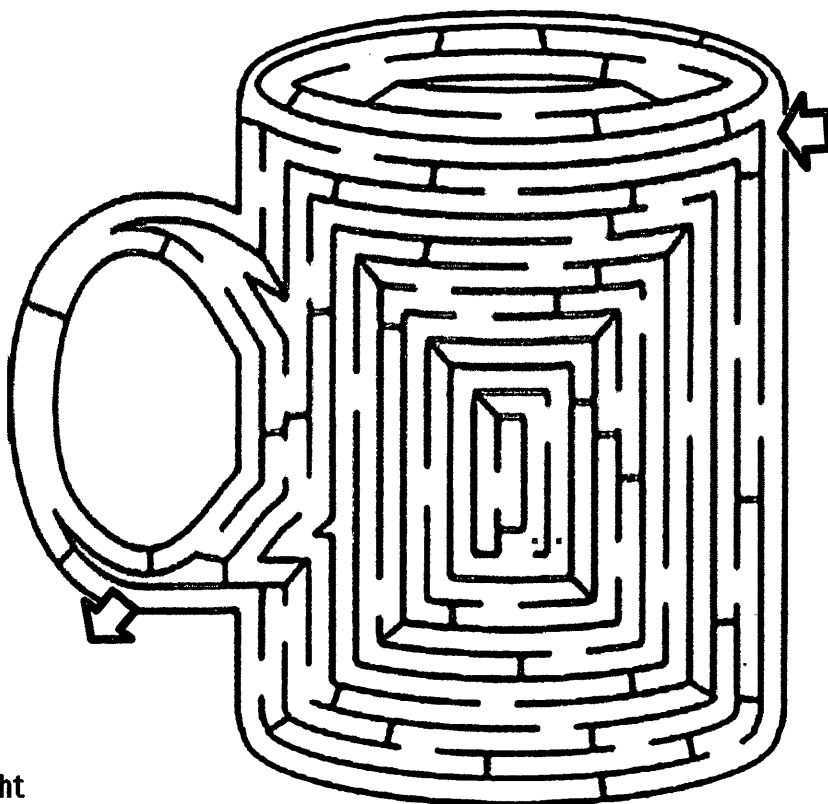

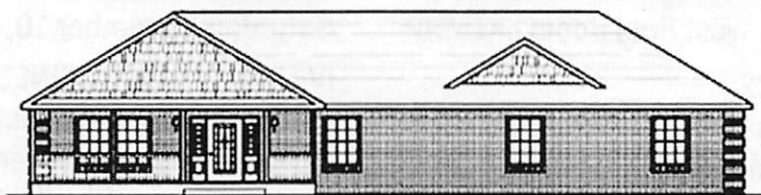

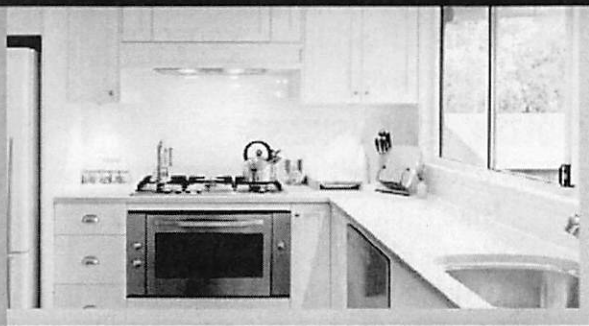


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KEARNEY LODGE NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

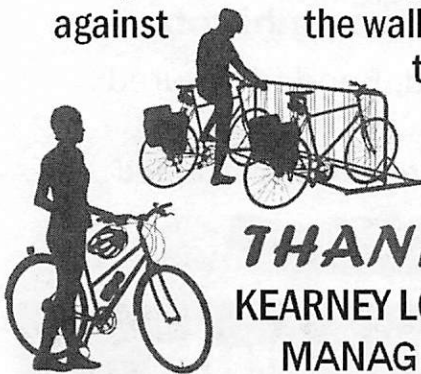

We will be working with KL management to keep Kearney Lodge SAFE at all times, but we need all your help, Observe and report.

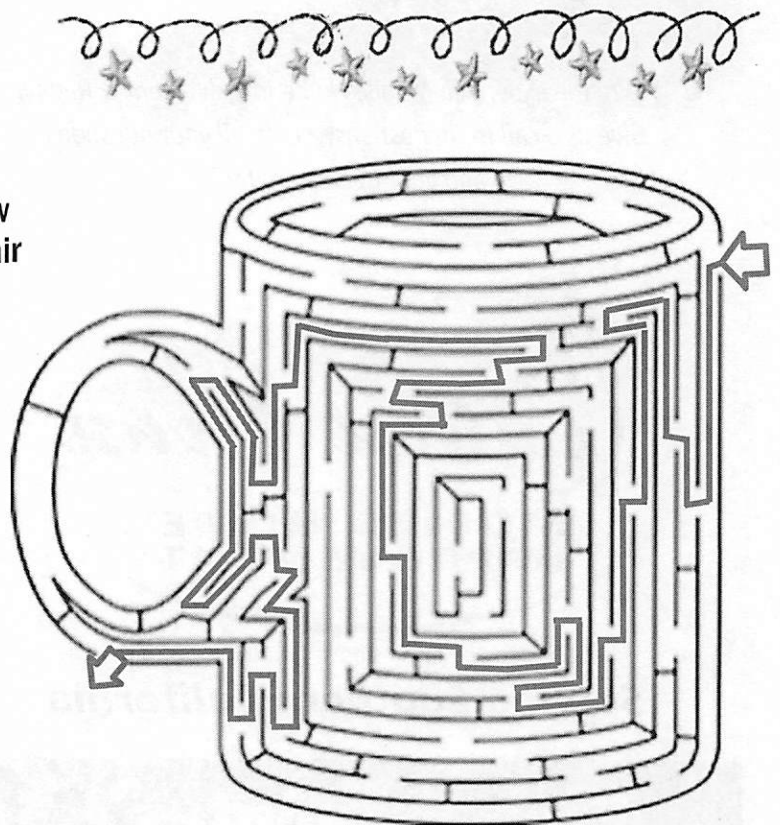
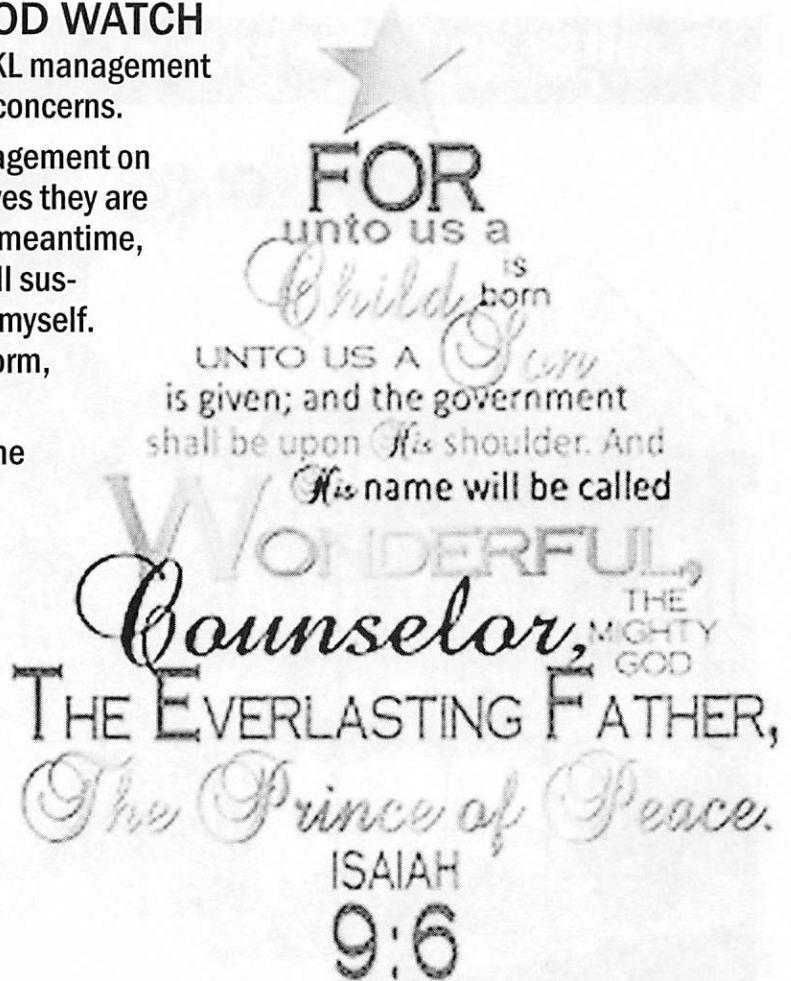

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WHAT IS XMAS?

Here's a holiday surprise that only the dictionary can provide. Do you find the word "Xmas," as an abbreviation for Christmas, offensive? Many do.

You won't find Xmas in church songbooks or even on many greeting cards. Xmas is popularly associated with a trend towards materialism, and sometimes the target of people who decry the emergence of general "holiday" observance instead of particular cultural and religious ritual.

But the history of the word "Xmas" is actually more respectable, and fascinating, than you might suspect. First of all, the abbreviation predates by centuries its use in gaudy advertisements. It was first used in the mid-1500s.

"X" is the Greek letter "chi," the initial letter in the word *Χριστός*. And *Χριστός* means "Christ." "X" has been an acceptable representation of the word "Christ" for hundreds of years. This device is known as a Christogram.

The *mas* in Xmas is the Old English word for "mass." In the same vein, the dignified terms *Xpian* and *Xtian* have been used in place of the word "Christian."

WHAT IS HANUKKAH?

Hanukkah is celebrated around the world for eight days and nights.

Hanukkah celebrates the victory of the Maccabees or Israelites over the Greek-Syrian ruler, Antiochus, about 2200

years ago. A Menorah is a nine-branched candelabrum, also known in Hebrew as a Hanukiah.

In 168 BCE, King Antiochus IV ruled over ancient Israel. Not being a fan of variety, he demanded that if a person didn't pray to the Greek gods and share in his same culture, that person would be in trouble.

This was a problem for the Jews, who still wanted to partake in Jewish traditions like studying the Torah and celebrating Shabbat. This made some of the Jewish people so angry that they decided to disobey the king. Priest Mattathias and his sons were joined by other Jews to fight back against King Antiochus IV.

One son, Judah, or Judah the Maccabee, stepped into the spotlight, leading all of his fellow fighters, the Maccabees, in an attempt to save their Jewish heritage. Even as the king's soldiers rode in on elephants to attack, the Maccabees stayed strong and drove them right out of Jerusalem.

Upon their victory, the Maccabees cleaned up the Temple and decided to light a menorah, an oil-burning lamp. As the story goes, they only had enough oil to burn for one day, but miraculously, the oil lasted for eight days and eight nights. That is why Hanukkah is celebrated for eight days, lighting another candle in the menorah each night to remember this miracle and the triumph of the Jews.

A person must be extra vigilant during this season when there are new sights, smells, sounds and things to play with. Here are tips to avoid common health and safety dangers your pets face during this otherwise cheery season:

1. Check that your pet is wearing a collar/tag.
2. Update your pet's microchip.
3. Remind guests to be careful at doors.
4. Stay on schedule.
5. Don't leave pets alone for days.
6. Make sure your pet gets regular exercise.
7. Avoid bringing pet toxic plants in the house.
8. Hide electric cords.
9. Keep tree decorations out of reach.
10. Don't let pets drink from the tree.
11. Don't leave lighted candles unattended.
12. Be careful where you leave presents.
13. Quickly dispose of wrapping paper.
14. Give your pet(s) space to be alone.
15. Be careful with adult beverages.
16. Keep toys and treats handy.
17. Watch counter surfers and food bandits.
18. Keep the pets paws off the table.
19. Remind guests not to feed pets table scraps.
20. After a meal, remove all trash, leftovers and bones immediately.
21. Know who to call in a pet emergency.

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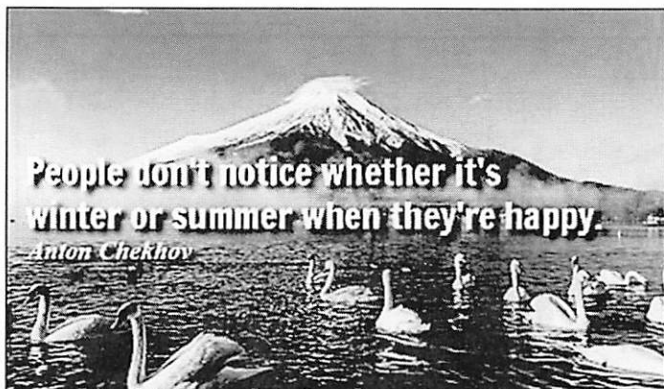
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WHAT IS HAPPENING IN K. L. PARK?

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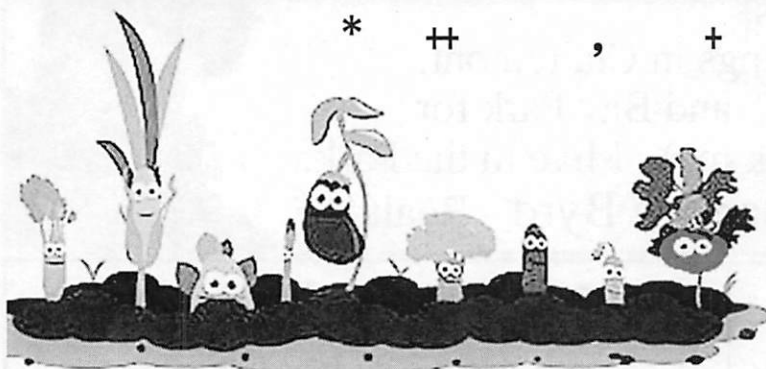
